Incident Details

Upon return to the Dala unit at Maples Adolescent Treatment Centre after visiting § 22 and having dinner with § 22 in the community.

§ 22 returned to Dala from preplanned visit with § 22 and dinner with § 22 at 22:10. While checking in with staff, the nurse (Roxanne) noticed an odor coming from § 22 and queried it was alcohol. She confronted him about same and he denied alcohol use but admitted to smoking marijuana with § 22 in the community prior to meeting § 22 for dinner. Was open and honest in discussing this. Allowed nurse to take vitals which were normal. Placed on medical S/A for drug use as of 22:10.

Bifrost Program, Maples Adolescent Treatment Centre

Youth did not complete his Mental Status Examination during the Bifrost Program. Youth also did not complete his About My Life questionnaire. Youth refused to complete same. Primary workers continued to offer opportunities throughout the cycle numerous times, doing everything reasonably possible to engage youth to complete these admission requirements. A Mental Status Examination was scheduled with the Bifrost Psychiatrist on two occasions but youth chose not to attend.

front door to Maples school left unlocked, notified by security guard.

Front door facing parking lot left unlocked, writer informed by security guard. Writer notified unit pc who suggested writer call bifrost pc as he may have a key. Writer phoned Steve Sjoberg who said he would come in and lock the door. Security informed writer when door was locked by pc.
