

CONDITIONAL WATER LICENCE

With reference to the water application of the company for the use of water from Seton and Cayoosh Creeks on Lot 3, Lillocet District, it is noted that the application covers the use of water for domestic purposes as well as irrigation. I do not remember any mention of domestic use being made when I discussed this application with Mr. R. G. Garry in Lillocet on July 9th, and from the nature of the works proposed it would not appear that water could be obtained from the proposed system during the winter. It would, therefore, be appreciated if you would confirm whether domestic use is required.

At the time of my inspection it was understood that water is piped to the house on the property from Copeland Spring, on which the company holds Final Water Licence 4750, for irrigation purpose. If, as appears likely, the spring is being used only for domestic purpose, it is suggested that the company might apply to the Comptroller of Water Rights to have this licence amended from irrigation to domestic purpose.






