

Re: Watershed Protection Clauses for Community
Watersheds Located in Forest Reserves

The watershed protection clauses quoted in your letter dated September 24, 1973 deal with watershed sanitation requirements which as location of camp buildings, etc., and waste disposal.

There would, however, appear to be other matters of concern related to logging practices which should be considered in order to protect water quality in a community watershed. Mr. R.W. Robbins of your Division, a member of the Task Force, outlined in a letter dated June 15, 1972 (copy attached) the Forest Service Acts, Policies and Regulations. Under item P-1, five clauses are listed which are designed to provide protection of streams, stream-beds and lakes. These clauses should be included in a Timber Sale contract in a community watershed as a safeguard against water quality degradation.

In addition to the above clauses, I refer you to a letter dated September 29, 1972 (Forest Service File 04155) from Mr. I.T. Cameron to "All Licensees of Timber Sales, Tree Farm Licences and Timber Sale Harvesting Licenses in the Coast Region of British Columbia". Some of the planning guidelines for logging which accompany this letter could serve to guide your office in the formation of specific protective clauses designed to minimize potential deleterious effects on the water quality in community watersheds located in Forest Reserve areas.

It would be appreciated if such action could be taken on an interim basis as further recommendations for logging in community watersheds may result from the deliberations of the Task Force.

FOREST SERVICE ACTS REGULATIONS & POLICIES

Forest Act

- The Forest Service has jurisdiction over and shall control and administer all matters relating to or in anywise connected with forestry and shall control, regulate, receive and administer
 - (a) all interests in Crown timber

(b) all revenues from Crown timber

- (c) sale and disposition of Crown timber (Section 5)
- The Minister shall cause an examination of Crown lands to be made by the Forest Service for the purpose of establishing a permanent Forest Reserve. When such has been Proclaimed by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, all Crown land therein is withdrawn from sale, settlement and occupancy under provisions of the Land Act, or Taxation Act, and in respect of the Mineral Act, Placer-mining Act, Coal Act, and Petroleum and Natural Gas Act shall be subject to such conditions as the Lieutenant-Governor in Council imposes. After such Proclamation no Crown land within the Forest Reserve shall be sold, leased or otherwise disposed of and no person shall use or occupy any part of the land except under the provisions of this Act or of the regulations. Forest reserves shall be under the control and management of the Minister for the maintenance of timber, and for the protection of the water supply. (Section 33)

Regulations

The Minister may determine and define the uses and (or) occupation and any activities within a Forest Reserve for which a permit will be required. (Section 4.02 B.C. Regs. 7/59, 208/71)

Trlicy.

- The Forest Service supports the concept of multiple-use of Forest Reserves.
 - The Forest Service is presently engaged in drawing up a Working Plan for each Public Sustained Yield Unit and solicits input in each plan from all Resource Agencies. Such input is anticipated to be of an inventory nature identifying specific values. The Working Plan will sum up all values in the Forest and lay down guidelines for the orderly use of all values.

PROTECTION OF OTHER USES AND RESERVATIONS

Protection of Streams, Stream-beds and Lakes

- P-1 . "Unless otherwise authorized by the Forest Officer, the Licensee shall:
 - (a) not allow any trees, logs, logging debris, or any substance likely to cause pollution to be deposited at any time within any lake or stream.
 - (b) not allow any logs to be skidded, equipment to be operated, gravel to be displaced or any damage to be done within the highwater level of any stream channel.
 - (c) provide all stream crossings with a bridge or culvert, the design of which will accommodate maximum stream flow and permit unobstructed fish passage and schedule the construction of all stream crossings as directed by the Forest Officer.
 - (d) not place any obstruction or fill within the highwater level of any stream channel.
 - (e) remove any logging, milling or road building debris deposited in any stream channel or lake as directed by the Forest Officer."

> This office has received several requests for map reserves forwarded to us from the Department of Lands for watershed purposes.

Prior to establishing these map notations within forest reserves could you elucidate just what rights are required to be reserved?

As you are probably aware, this department has watershed protection clauses as follows:-

> This licence lies within the Watershed Reserve, and the Licensee shall observe all laws and regulations which may be made by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council respecting sanitation and the protection of the purity of waters which are applicable to the lands covered by this licence and also comply with any requirements which may be made by the Minister of Health Services and Hospital Insurance."

"The Licensee shall at all times comply with the following special conditions:-

- (a) Locate all camp buildings, outhouses, cesspools, stables, and other structures at a distance not less than three hundred (300) feet from any watercourse or stream, lake, or other source of water
- (b) Immediately remove and bury or burn any camp refuse or debris of any description, or any substance which would be likely to cause pollution of any waters."

These clauses can be inserted in any timber sale within these areas if this is required. If something more is required please advise.
