You Bet Ian. There will be a media release in this week's Valley Sentinel and then more details can be discussed after.

After DFO received preliminary charge approval from the PPSC, the investigation team agreed to attempt to for-go that option of court and attempted to receive an agreement with the MCFC to participate in a Restorative Justice Forum instead of a court proceeding. At that point I phased out of the picture and Mike Jones, the RJ Coordinator, was the DFO contact.

The RJ forum was held on Oct 30th in McBride. I did not attend but Don Lawrence, the DFO Biologist was one of the Forum members representing the community. 5 other persons were selected by Mike Jones and represented persons of the McBride community who were politically neutral.

I spoke anxiously with Mike Jones and Don Lawrence hours after the forum to get the scoop on how things went and I was assured that things went very well. I will send you the press release that Mike Jones approved as soon as it is released in the news paper as it was part of the agreement with MCFC.
