I am writing further to your request for review sent to the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner for BC (OIPC) on February 21, 2014. Your request for review related to the application of exceptions to withhold information in the response sent to you by the Ministry of Energy and Mines on November 27, 2013. Your original request was for:

The report recently completed by Doug Flynn of Skeena region in Smithers into the death of Pat Desmarais at Seabridge Gold's KSM project on October 12, 2012; The relevant fatality report and all supporting documents, photographs, interview notes, phone notes and email or paper correspondence related to that investigation and its report.

The Ministry has reconsidered its original decision and is providing you with information that was previously withheld pursuant to section 13 (Policy advice or recommendations) of FOIPPA. You will note that some information continues to be withheld pursuant to sections 15 (Disclosure harmful to law enforcement), 17 (Disclosure harmful to the financial or economic interests of a public body), and 22 (Disclosure harmful to personal privacy) of FOIPPA.
