I am writing further to your request received by the Office of the Premier. Your request is for:

Any records, speaking notes, cabinet submissions, minutes or proceedings from Caucus, from Orders in Council or the Office of the Premier associated with Fraser Valley Access, request guided, but not limited to the following submission dates: June 12, 1991 (Cabinet Submission) and June 25, 1991 (Chairman's report). Date range is June 1, 1991 to October 17, 1991.

On September 27, 2013 you clarified that you are not seeking any duplicate records that you have already received through previous FOI Requests. Nor did you wish to receive any "public commentary" records (correspondence from the public to the Office of the Premier).
