Peter Schouten of Heppel's farm called me and let me know that they had made a mistake and contacted Debbie Henderson of E.S. Cropconsult (602-266-6560) to take a look at the foliar damage caused by their pesticide application. They also called the manufacturer and confirmed that they had changed the formula. He and Debbie came up with the hypothesis (based on research and observations) that the pesticide had vapourized and blown around in the wind. He said that he was embarrassed about the situation and has been in touch with about 8-10 people in the affected neighbourhood. He said that he was planning an open house at the farm for neighbours that live around Heppel's potato fields to let them know about what they do and how they do it. He told Sue Garnet of the PMRA what had happened and what they plan to do. He also said that this had never happened before, and they are taking measures so that they understand what is happening a bit more.

Carol McGrath of Industry Canada (604-666-4663) and Peter Schouten of Heppel's Potato Corporation, informed me that we would be able to direct any further complaints or issues regarding pesticide spraying and damage caused by Heppel's to herself, as the land Heppel's is using is being leased to them by Industry Canada.






