Luge Canada provided us with the additional information: The final tally of athletes and countries are as follows: 12 countries and 72 athletes (CAN, USA, GER, AUT, UKR, RUS, SUI, NOR, SLO, TPE, and CZE). The reason we had less than we originally thought was due to the fact the races took place the year after the Olympics. All winter sports have a smaller budget this year and so some countries that usually travel to these races did not come.
