is hereby authorized to divert and use water as follows:—

(a) The source of the water-supply ~~is~~ are MacCrimmon, Shamrock and Callon Creeks.(b) The points of diversion ~~is~~ are located as shown on the attached plan.

(c) The date from which this licence shall have precedence is 23rd February 1925.

(d) The purpose for which the water is to be used is Industrial.

(e) The maximum quantity of water which may be diverted is 1,000,000 gallons a day

(f) The period of the year during which the water may be used is the whole year.

(g) The land upon which the water is to be used and to which this licence is appurtenant is the portion of South East $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 15, Township 16, East Coast Meridian, shown on Registered Sketch 7844 New Westminster Land Registration District.

(h) The works authorized hereunder are Dams, Tanks, Pumps and Pipes

(i) This licence is issued in substitution of Conditional Water Licence No. 4826, 6453 and 11210, hereby surrendered and cancelled.

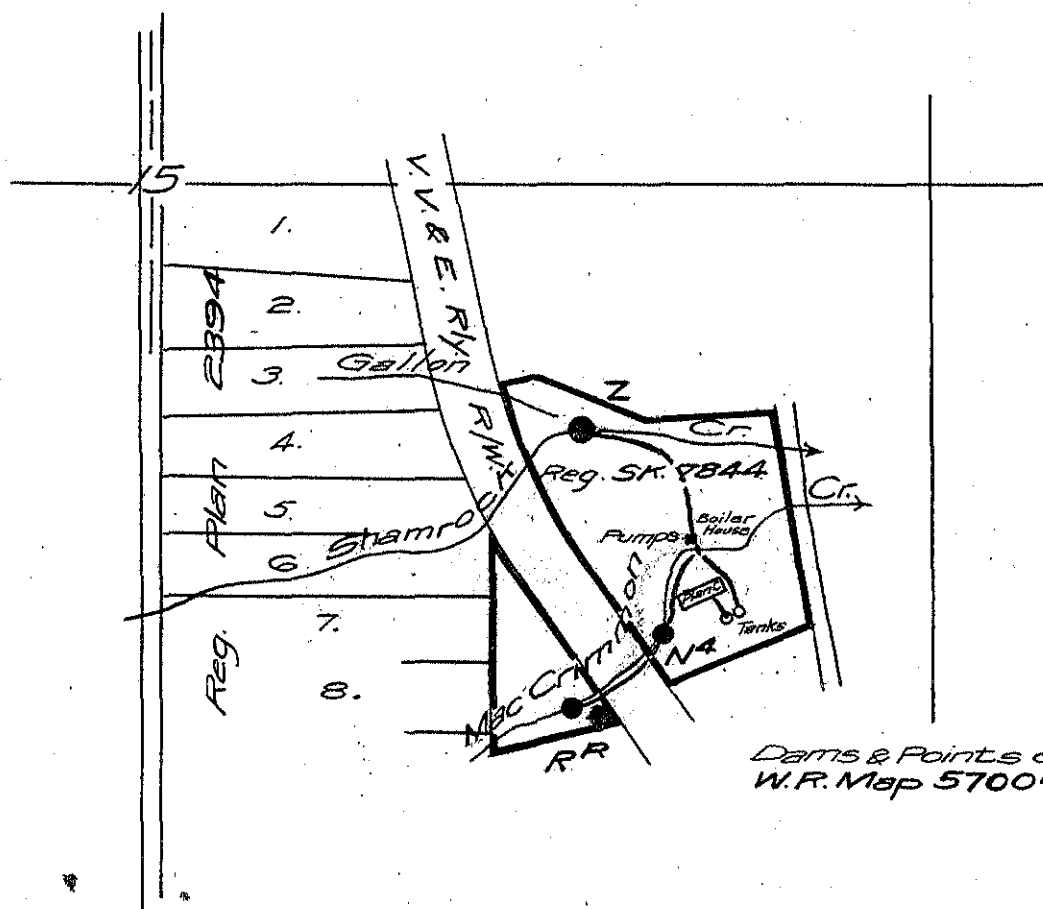
