EDUC "call for projects" from school districts are approved based on the following criteria:

- 1. Emissions reduction levels
- 2. Operational cost savings
- 3. Contributions from school district
- 3<sup>rd</sup> party contributions (e.g. BC Hydro/Fortis BC incentives)
- Criteria 1 and 2 are more heavily weighted than 3 and 4.
- Projects must be completed in the year they are approved
- EDUC tries to ensure CNCP funding is equitably distributed across all school districts over a number of years
- EDUC tries to have each school district's carbon offset costs paid back every 5 years

So here is basically how it works for SD's:

- The SDs pay about \$5M/yr. to buy offsets from PCT.
- EDUC now has an annual routine capital budget of this much, but the commitment to each SD is to keep them whole over a 5-year period, not each year.
- There is a call for proposals process each year, and SDs submit projects that involve renos to save energy window replacement, boilers, etc.
- EDUC adjudicates the proposals and pays out the funds based on their assessments.
