I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Finance. Your request is for:

The cost/benefit analysis, feasibility study and business case for: A new price-based wholesale pricing model for alcoholic beverages; The store-within-a-store concept of liquor sales in grocery stores and VQA wine sales in grocery stores. Date range is September 1, 2013 to March 7, 2014.

The Ministry has reconsidered its initial position to deny access to the records found in response to your request in favour of partial disclosure.
