I am writing further to your request received by the Government Communications and Public Engagement. Your request is for:

Copies of all records, including but not limited to e-mails, text or Instant messages, memos, meeting agendas, meeting notes, briefing notes, technical reports, media lines, backgrounders, etc., regarding the Peace valley landslide that began overnight on Sept 29-30, including all references to the Site C dam project and related work. Please provide records electronically, exclude public correspondence, media requests and media responses. (Date Range for Record Search: From 09/30/2018 To 10/12/2018)

You requested a review of the public body's severing decisions for pages 141-145, specifically, with the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner (OIPC). The public body has reconsidered previously withheld information pursuant to section 15 (Disclosure harmful to law enforcement) of FOIPPA from the records provided to you on February 19, 2019.
