Please note the following:

- Income thresholds for families who are eligible to receive child care benefit in ACCB are higher than CCS. Families with pre-tax incomes of \$45,000 or less will receive the full benefit, up to the cost of care, while those who make up to \$111,000 will receive a reduced amount, scaling according to income. Since a greater percentage of families with higher income received ACCB payments, the average amount of ACCB per child in September 2018 is lower than the average amount of CCS per child in August 2018.
- Information is as of Nov 21, 2018, and organized by when the child received child care.
