Our request is particularly directed to: • Date range of interest is April 1, 2012 to December 31, 2014; • the work of Ms. Anne Moody in reviewing the draft amendments to the Ministry of Mines Permit and any consideration of reclamation; • the work of other MEM staff in assessing the application of the Mines Code to draft amendments, and in particular any consideration of reclamation by MEM.
