*Regarding the current amendment of October 28, 2015 for Permit Q-8-094 Mine No. 1610355: A copy of the Mines Inspector reports approving completion of all previous cells; A copy of the As-built for the area of the mine that has received contaminated waste up to July 05, 2016; A copy of the As-built and the Mines Inspector's approval of the As-built for the new, effective July 05, 2016, soil containment area which is triangular - approximately 40 m on the NW face, 60m on the SW face, 60m on the NE face of the triangle; The written approval of the Inspector that allows the operator to work in multiple soil containment areas at one time. (Date Range for Record Search: From 02/01/2015 To 07/05/2016)*
