*Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)*

- FIN-2017-71855 A copy of the records disclosed for FOI file JAG-2012-01544, which was a request for: All Briefing Notes to the Minister prepared between July 1, 2012 to September 1, 2012.
- FIN-2017-71856 A copy of the records disclosed for FOI file JAG-2012-01554, which was a request for: Any and all briefing notes to the Minister prepared between May 19, 2012 and September 7, 2012 excluding any attachments that are already publicly available.
