You requested a review of the public body's severing decisions with the Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner (OIPC). Due to the passage of time during mediation, the public body has reconsidered previously withheld information pursuant to section(s) 13 (Policy advice or recommendations), of FOIPPA from the records provided to you on February 4, 2019.
