## Re: Request for Access to Records Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)

Monthly Interior Log Market reports for the Prince George milling community specific to SPF Sawlog and Pulpwood Volumes in cubic metres and Average Price in dollars per cubic metre. The mills operating during the term of our data range request include Canfor Polar, Canfor PG Sawmill, Canfor Pulp Limited Partnership, Canfor Isle Pierre, Carrier Lumber, Dollar Saver lumber, Dunkley Lumber, Lakeland Mills, Stella Jones and other small operators. (Date Range for Record Search: From 01/01/2004 To 12/31/2015)
