I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development. Your request is for:

The number of human induced grizzly bear fatalities as a result of human-bear conflict in the Bella Coola valley (Tweedsmuir Population unit) over the last 30 years, broken down by year; The number of grizzly bear fatalities from the same human-bear conflict causes over the last 30 years in all of British Columbia, broken down by year. Human-bear conflict induced fatalities, in my opinion, should include: poaching, euthanization from COS (a.k.a animal control), bears killed by citizens, vehicle strikes. Exclude Limited Entry Hunts or any other sanctioned hunting kills. (Date Range for Record Search: From 1/1/1990 To 11/21/2019)

The records located in response to your request will be delivered through the BC Secure File Transfer Service.
