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**Re: Request for Access to Records
Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)**

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Forests. Your request is for:

Regarding the forest service bridge which crosses the Blaeberry River downstream of the OB campground on the Blaeberry forest service road, near Golden BC; Records from the Forest Services showing the posted weight bearing limit of this bridge from the time it was first operational until June 30, 1980.; Records of the date the weight bearing limit was posted, and whether or not there was always a sign indicating the weight bearing load limit of said bridge, up to and including August 30, 1980; Records of the date the weight bearing limit was posted, and whether or not there was always a sign indicating the weight bearing load limit of said bridge, up to and including August 30, 1980.; Records of if such signage was removed, for some reason, or due to vandalism, was it ever replaced, and if this scenario exists please provide dates and explanations; Records on whether the bridge was ever inspected in 1980 for any reason, including the safety issues regarding the e bridge; Copy of any reports, notes, notes from verbatim conversations, or records pertaining to such a report. (Date Range for Record Search: From 1/1/1975 To 12/30/1983)
