Any report or review that led to the conclusion that the problem with the party bus door in the incident that killed Chelsea James was “an intermittent issue that would have been extremely difficult for an inspector to find” as per GCPE’s response to a request for information; Any correspondence among Ministry staff, CVSE, or GCPE that informed the bus line that a request for information was submitted on Sunday, October 28 to Monday, October 29, 2018.
