The Interprovincial Physician Compensation Report produced per the 2007 Physician Master Agreement, dated December 31, 2010, and all subsequent reports surveying Interprovincial Physician Compensation. (Date Range for Record Search: From 12/31/2010 To 04/04/2016)

Please find enclosed a copy of the records located in response to your request. These records are provided to you in their entirety. Your file is now closed.

Please note that there is only one Interprovincial Physician Compensation Report. The Ministry supplied this explanation for why there are no follow-up reports:

From the documentation I've been able to find, the reasons there are no follow up reports to the Interprovincial Physician Compensation Report are the following:

- Resource constraints and methodological difficulties in collecting the data necessary to produce the report
- The need to gather data from other provinces would require data sharing agreements and ensuring data quality and consistency, with little incentive for other provinces (particularly Alberta and Ontario) to participate
- Little reason to think that the government and the BCMA would agree on how to use/interpret results of the model.
