**Re: Request for Access to Records**  
***Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)***

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Health. Your request is for:

*Records indicating the number of health cards - i.e. identification card for provincial health insurance - reported lost or stolen during 2016.*

Please find enclosed a copy of the records located in response to your request. These records are provided to you in their entirety. Please note that the BC Services Card has replaced the Carecard, and it is designed to make it easier for B.C. residents to access provincial government services (including Medical Services Plan benefits and services that need a photo ID) with just one card. Previously, photo ID cards and Carecards were separate before the combined card was introduced.

This response is only reflective of the non-photo card portion of your request. The Ministry has been advised that the Insurance Corporation of British Columbia (ICBC) has also received your request through a partial transfer on April 25, 2017, for records responsive to the photo card portion of your request.

Please await responses from the Ministry of Technology, Innovation, and Citizens' Services and ICBC before considering government's response to be complete.

Your file with the Ministry of Health is now closed.

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These records will be published on the BC Government's Open Information website a minimum of five business days after release.
