I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Attorney General. You narrowed your request on July 9, 2019 via email with Patrick Craib. Your request is for:

*A copy of the most up to date Question Period Binder response book used by the Minister, Minister of State or Parliamentary Secretary for the Spring 2019 Session. (Date Range for Record Search: From 01/01/2019 to 07/09/2019)*

The records located in response to your request will be delivered through the BC Secure File Transfer Service. Separate emails will follow from the BC SFT Notification Service directing you how to set up an account and where to obtain your records. Some information has been withheld pursuant to section(s) 12 (Cabinet and local public body confidences), 13 (Policy advice or recommendations), 14 (Legal advice), 17 (Disclosure harmful to the financial or economic interests of a public body), 21 (Disclosure harmful to business interests of a third party) and 22 (Disclosure harmful to personal privacy) of FOIPPA. Information that is a court record, a record of a judge of the Court of Appeal, Supreme Court or Provincial Court, a record of a master of the Supreme Court, a record of a justice of the peace, a judicial administration record or a record relating to support services provided to the judges of those courts has been removed pursuant to section 3(1)(a) of FOIPPA.

You directed your request to multiple public bodies which may have records responsive to your request. As you have already directed an identically worded request across government ministries, they will respond under separate cover. Please await responses to each of your requests before considering government's response to be complete. Your file is now closed.
