Regarding the development of Clean BC and modelling of the impacts of Clean BC measures on BC's greenhouse gas emissions, as recorded in supporting the development of CleanBC: Methodology report for assessing the impacts of CleanBC policies (the "Navius Report"). Instructions, contracts, notes of meetings, or other records providing Navius with stated assumptions, limitations or other factors to be incorporated into Navius' modelling of the Greenhouse Gas emission reductions associated with CleanBC, or into the Navius Report; Drafts of the Navius Report, or related modelling or results, including drafts of the Navius' Report provided to the government for review; Correspondence, comments, feedback or discussions between the Public bodies and/or Navius concerning the Navius Report, and related modelling or results; Correspondence, comments, feedback or discussions between the Public bodies and/or Navius concerning the most appropriate sectors or industrial categories to use in modelling in the Navius Report; and Correspondence, comments, feedback or discussions between the Public bodies and/or Navius related to the relationship between the GHG emissions modelled in the Navius Report and BC's legislated 2030, 2040 and/or 2050 targets.
