I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction. You narrowed your request on October 18, 2017 through conversation and/or email. Your request is for:

- 1) the number of welfare fraud investigations/reviews concluded as well as outcomes of these investigations/ reviews rather than "Reports completed as a result of Ministry initiatives"
- 2) the number of fraud allegations received from the public over the fiscal year rather than "Reports received by the Ministry from the public which were reviewed/investigated/actioned"

MSD cannot produce data on fraud investigate as a percentage of caseload as this is something they do not track. However, what the ministry can produce has been provided to you. Please find enclosed a copy of the records located in response to your request. These records are provided to you in their entirety. Your file is now closed.
