I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction. Your request is for:

*A Record or Records setting out a copy of the Schedule of Fee Allowances dated 1995 that was placed on file with the office of the Deputy Minister in 2002; A Record or Records setting out a copy of the Schedule of Fee Allowances (Dentures) dated 1993 that was placed on file with the office of the Deputy Minister in 2002; A Record or Records of the Dental Fee Schedules for Dental Fee Allowances, and Denture Allowances that were in effect for the years 2004 and 2006; A record or record indicating where the Schedule of Fee Allowances for Dental Fees or Dentures came from. (Date Range for Record Search: From 01/01/2002 To 01/01/2007)*

Please find enclosed a copy of the records located in response to your request. These records are provided to you in their entirety. We have provided you with the best available copy, although you may find that some pages are in poor condition. Your file is now closed.

Please be advised that the ministry is unable to provide one document (Dental Mechanic Fee Schedule dated July 1, 2002) as they searched all available records and could not locate this record. Also, the Ministry does not have any records for "A record or record indicating where the Schedule of Fee Allowances for Dental Fees or Dentures came from". All the documents provided are ministry-initiated documents.
