I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Social Development and Poverty Reduction. Your request is for:

Records that show the percentage of Social Assistance recipients (i.e. Income Assistance and Disability Assistance) in the City of Vancouver that receive their payments through the following methods: Direct Deposit; Cheques (mailed); Cheques (picked up). The period of interest is 2005 to 2019. A snapshot of each year is sufficient (e.g. the percentages for January of each month). If it is time consuming to separate mailed vs picked up cheques, it is sufficient to merge both together.

(Date Range for Record Search: From 1/1/2005 To 9/30/2019)
