I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General. Your request is for:

For the period of January 1, 2004 to December 31, 2019 the number of federal prisoners who were released under Criminal Code of Canada Section 810 orders to be supervised in the community by BC provincial probation officers.

These records are provided to you in their entirety. The Ministry has created records for 2017 to 2019. As per section 6 (2) (b) of the Act (see attached), it would unreasonably interfere with their operations to create records for 2004 to 2016. Your file is now closed.

Duty to assist applicants

6 (1) The head of a public body must make every reasonable effort to assist applicants and to respond without delay to each applicant openly, accurately and completely.

(2) Moreover, the head of a public body must create a record for an applicant if

(a) the record can be created from a machine readable record in the custody or under the control of the public body using its normal computer hardware and software and technical expertise, and

(b) creating the record would not unreasonably interfere with the operations of the public body.
