Re: Request for Access to Records Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPPA)

I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Public Safety and Solicitor General. Your request is for:

Statistics on the number of temporary absences and releases from correctional institutions related to COVID-19 pandemic prevention and management. As well, Records documenting the number and nature of grievances related to COVID-19 submitted by people on probation and other individuals currently on community release, as well as staff in probation offices. (Date Range for Record Search: From 3/1/2020 To 3/31/2020)

The Ministry has provided the following in response to your request:

BC Corrections began issuing communicable disease Temporary Absences (TA) for individuals serving intermittent sentences on March 16, 2020, when it was considered safe and appropriate to do so. In March 2020, a total of 43 TAs were issued.

In addition, TA's for individuals serving a straight-time sentence (with less than 30 days remaining) began on March 30, 2020. A total of eight TAs were issued between March 30, 2020, and April 5, 2020.
