*A complete copy of all records regarding the intersections of Brown Road and Dobbin Road and Elliot Road and Dobbin Road in the City of West Kelowna which the Ministry has in its custody or control relating to the following including without limiting the generality of the foregoing: Brown Road/Dobbin Road intersection; Elliot Road/Dobbin Road intersection; All sidewalks; All pedestrian crosswalks; Lights, signs, traffic control devices, etc.; Photos and/or surveillance of the intersections of Brown Road and Dobbin Road and Elliot Road and Dobbin Road from 10:00am to 12:00pm on September 4, 2016; Any and all complaints pertaining to the intersection and/or traffic control devices at Brown Road and Dobbin Road in the District of West Kelowna; Any and all documents pertaining to the intersection and/or traffic control devices at the intersection of Brown Road and Dobbin Road and the intersection of Elliot Road and Dobbin Road in the District of West Kelowna.
