I am writing further to your request received by the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure. Your request is for:

Regarding the Nov. 29, 2016 briefing on Evergreen Line financials by Amanda Farrell: All underlying documents that form the basis for the figures that were disseminated to media and the public, specifically, the most-recent, complete, detailed and definitive project financial report that has been reviewed by Ministry auditors, showing all expenses to date submitted by SNC-Lavalin, EGRT and other contractors and subcontractors, and projected expenses through the end of the project. (Date Range for Record Search: From 11/01/2016 To 12/02/2016)

The Ministry has provided the following explanatory note:

The applicant requested “the most-recent, complete, detailed and definitive project financial report that has been reviewed by Ministry auditors, showing all expenses to date submitted by SNC-Lavalin, EGRT and other contractors and subcontractors, and projected expenses through the end of the project”; however the Evergreen Line financial information has only been audited to March 31, 2016 which is contained in the Province’s 2015/16 Public Accounts.
