In addition, any original applications and materials in support of said applications that resulted in the issuance of the following motor carrier licences: Greyhound Canada Transportation Corp. (Motor Carrier Licence 51380); Greyhound Lines Inc. (Motor Carrier Licence Unknown), which authorized a licence or special authorization for transportation services from Vancouver to the Washington State border. In addition, any original applications and materials in support of a motor carrier licence, special authorization, or any other authorization, to Boltbus (which is exclusively owned and operated by Greyhound Lines, Inc.).
