1. Northeast B.C. school districts get \$70,000 in trades training funds - Chris Newton - 28-Sept-2017 - Online – [positive]

Three school districts in Northeast B.C. are getting \$70,000 from the Industry Training Authority to support the Youth Work in Trades Programs for the upcoming school year.

"Throughout Northeastern British Columbia, ITA Youth in Trades programs give high school students a chance to sample the many possibilities they might enjoy in their future," says Melanie Mark, Minister of Advanced Education, Skills and Training. "Trades students are the ones who will help build our homes, schools and hospitals. We want to meet labour market demands by equipping British Columbians with the right skills and education for the job opportunities of today and tomorrow."

1. The logical next step: Naloxone kits on campus - Braden Klassen - The Runner - 28-Sept-2017 – Online – [neutral]

"UBC has a program that provides take-home overdose kits to students for free, so why doesn't KPU? It seems that the common perception is that overdoses occur so rarely among student populations that making Naloxone a standard addition to first-aid kits goes above and beyond the necessary efforts to prepare for emergency situations. In other words, it's unnecessary. Even if that is the case for now, statistics are showing that the overdose epidemic is growing rapidly, predominantly in B.C., and seems likely to reach even more monstrous proportions before it's brought under control."

2. Is UBC still a House of Cards? - Sarah Neubauer - The Ubyyssey - 29-Sept-2017 – Online – [negative]

At the September 12 Board of Governors meeting, seismic events and the potential for subsequent fires were identified as two of the highest risks to UBC. This was coupled with the reminder that it is a matter of "[not] if, but when" the Big One — a 9.0 magnitude or greater earthquake — will arrive.

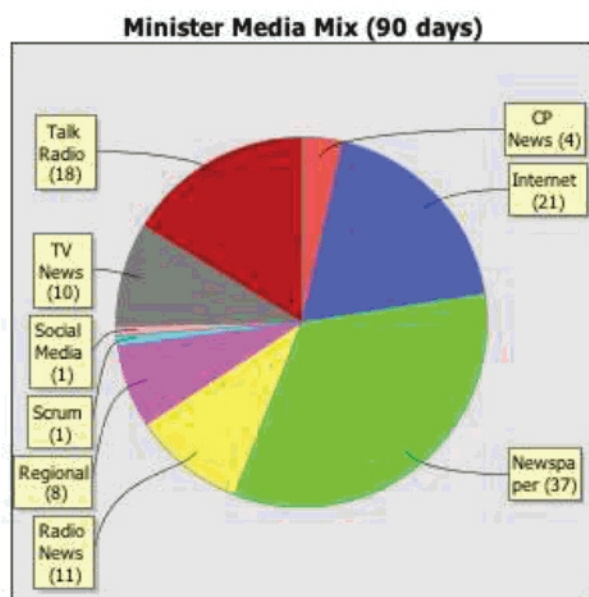
