Dear Government Partners,

Today I am reaching out for your support on a significant issue that we can and must address in British Columbia: Youth Homelessness. I am also requesting that you or a senior representative of your Ministry join us on Wednesday, May $23^{\rm rd}$ in Vancouver to participate in our first in-person meeting as a first step in ending youth homelessness. We are asking for each of 10 key Ministries to identify a senior representative (Minister, Deputy Minister, ADM) to join youth, service providers and representatives from other Ministries for this provincially-supported event.

This issue is close to my heart as a young person who began experiencing the trauma of homelessness as a permanent ward of the government. Before the age of 19, I went through 28 different moves in the foster-care system where I toted all my belongings in garbage bags. When I aged out, I ended up living on the streets of Kamloops. My life touched all the ministries including health, mental health, public safety, social development, education and post-secondary. My trajectory of healing and out of homelessness was based on the support of your government to find a way home, which included more than the bricks and mortar.

Today I reach out to you as a young person with lived expertise of youth homelessness. The need is urgent and we must respond as we all have a responsibility and role to play in ensuring every youth has a way home. If one government ministry takes on the role of mom and dad,

we need all the other ministries to be aunties and uncles, community to be sisters and brothers, and the private sector to be cousins. We need to be family for those youth who have none. Young people are dying without a home and there is an urgent need to develop the services they need to be successful. I know firsthand the change that can be made when young people's potential are invested in, they will dedicate their lives to making a difference in others' lives. Youth with lived experience have the solution and we need you to listen.

In 2017, we founded BC Coalition to End Youth Homelessness which now includes more than 25 agencies from across BC and is growing every day to ensure geographic and service diversity and Indigenous representation. Our purpose is to develop a provincial plan to end youth homelessness with strategies for prevention, supports, housing, and information-sharing.

In February 2018, I had the opportunity to meet with Minister Robinson and Minister Simpson to share our strategy to develop a provincial plan to end youth homelessness. Funding was provided with the assistance of the Homeowner Protection Office, branch of BC Housing, to support us to bring together youth, BC communities, and inter-ministerial government partners to co-create priorities for a provincial plan to end youth homelessness. Please see details and deliverables on our attached one-pager.

We ask you to stand with us rooted in action to end youth homelessness in BC. Together we can make a difference in the lives of young people who are the future of our province.

Please accept this quick follow-up to our very brief introduction at the Health and Population Health Building announcement at Thompson Rivers University last Thursday. As I mentioned, our parent company, Maple Leaf Educational Systems, has been delivering the BC high school program at our schools in China since 1998, as the first BC offshore school and now the largest offshore school system. Our schools in China currently have about 8000 high school students registered as BC students and has graduated over 10,000 student since 1999 with approx. 70% of those coming to Canada for their post secondary studies.

In 2016 we established the Canadian subsidiary company with a mandate to open schools in Canada and eventually in the US. We are using a 'university school' model - university preparatory academic programs co-located on university campuses. The location of our schools on university campuses underscores for our students the academic, university preparatory focus of our schools and gives them access, through our space and services agreements, to university level libraries, science and technology labs, advanced dual credit courses and the many extra curricular opportunities on campus. At the same time, our school space on campus is removed from the general flow of the university students to provide a safe and highly identified school environment.



Dear Government Partners,

Today I am reaching out for your support on a significant issue that we can and must address in British Columbia: Youth Homelessness. I am also requesting that you or a senior representative of your Ministry join us on Wednesday, May $23^{\rm rd}$ in Vancouver to participate in our first in-person meeting as a first step in ending youth homelessness. We are asking for each of 10 key Ministries to identify a senior representative (Minister, Deputy Minister, ADM) to join youth, service providers and representatives from other Ministries for this provincially-supported event.

This issue is close to my heart as a young person who began experiencing the trauma of homelessness as a permanent ward of the government. Before the age of 19, I went through 28 different moves in the foster-care system where I toted all my belongings in garbage bags. When I aged out, I ended up living on the streets of Kamloops. My life touched all the ministries including health, mental health, public safety, social development, education and post-secondary. My trajectory of healing and out of homelessness was based on the support of your government to find a way home, which included more than the bricks and mortar.

Today I reach out to you as a young person with lived expertise of youth homelessness. The need is urgent and we must respond as we all have a responsibility and role to play in ensuring every youth has a way home. If one government ministry takes on the role of mom and dad,

we need all the other ministries to be aunties and uncles, community to be sisters and brothers, and the private sector to be cousins. We need to be family for those youth who have none. Young people are dying without a home and there is an urgent need to develop the services they need to be successful. I know firsthand the change that can be made when young people's potential are invested in, they will dedicate their lives to making a difference in others' lives. Youth with lived experience have the solution and we need you to listen.

In 2017, we founded BC Coalition to End Youth Homelessness which now includes more than 25 agencies from across BC and is growing every day to ensure geographic and service diversity and Indigenous representation. Our purpose is to develop a provincial plan to end youth homelessness with strategies for prevention, supports, housing, and information-sharing.

In February 2018, I had the opportunity to meet with Minister Robinson and Minister Simpson to share our strategy to develop a provincial plan to end youth homelessness. Funding was provided with the assistance of the Homeowner Protection Office, branch of BC Housing, to support us to bring together youth, BC communities, and inter-ministerial government partners to co-create priorities for a provincial plan to end youth homelessness. Please see details and deliverables on our attached one-pager.

We ask you to stand with us rooted in action to end youth homelessness in BC. Together we can make a difference in the lives of young people who are the future of our province.



The Right Honourable Paul Martin was Prime Minister of Canada (2003-2006) and Minister of Finance (1993 to 2002).

As Minister of Finance, he erased Canada's deficit, recorded five budget surpluses and set Canada's debt ratio on a steady downward track. He cofounded the Finance Minister' G-20.

Among his accomplishments as Prime Minister, Mr. Martin introduced a ten-year plan to improve healthcare and wait times; signed agreements with provinces and territories for the first national early learning and childcare program and created a new financial deal for Canada's municipalities.

Mr. Martin's first act as Prime Minister was to put in motion the process that led to the 2006 Kelowna Accord, a historic agreement with Indigenous people (First Nations, Métis and Inuit), booking funding of five billion dollars for the first five years to eliminate the funding gaps in education, healthcare and housing for Indigenous Canadians.

<u>CTV News reported</u> some six months ago that Statistics Canada assessed the number of Canadian citizens suffering from ME (also known as ME/CFS or SEID) in 2016 at around 560,000 – a dramatic increase from 405,000 in 2015, and more than the number of those suffering from breast cancer, Parkinson's, and Multiple Sclerosis combined. International studies are showing that <u>ME is more disabling than Multiple Sclerosis</u>, while Canadian research has clearly shown that <u>ME patients are the most underserved patients in Canada</u>, with the greatest unmet needs.

Despite the enormous numbers and the great suffering, ME is still not being taught in medical schools, and most doctors know little to nothing about the disease. ME research in Canada is still woefully underfunded, with only 35 cents allocated per patient, as compared with \$575 per patient for HIV/AIDS, which impacts around 80,000 patients.

Why is such an immense amount of personal suffering simply ignored, and such a

tremendous loss in productivity and societal participation by ME patients left unaddressed?

The answer: **Stigma**.

About Unrest

Jennifer Brea's incredible film is shattering the ignorance and preconceptions of audiences. She shines a light on the stigma faced by millions of patients around the world, showing the depth and breadth of the challenges faced by ME patients, many of who are left housebound and bedbound by this devastating disease.

Jennifer's personal story provides a compelling vehicle for the broader story of ME. While working on her Ph.D. at Harvard, and preparing for marriage with "the love of her life," Jennifer came down with a high fever and serious symptoms, none of which was taken seriously by the medical community. In search for answers, she decided to start recording her experiences with her cell phone. The result is a remarkable work.

Jen Brea has been taking her documentary to film festivals around the world, where it has won numerous awards, having been short listed for the 2018 Academy Awards for best feature documentary. The success and impact of her film has led to high profile media attention, with Jennifer making the rounds being interviewed by <u>major and local newspapers</u>, <u>radio and television</u>. She is a true hero in our cause, and we believe you will be moved, informed, shocked, and see hope in her wonderful documentary. It is not a pretty story that she tells, but she tells it very well.

Following the screening, a panel of local ME patients will participate in a Q & A.




