I have a message in to talk to the complainant, but I did talk to s.79 the owner:

- Two mink did escape, he recaptured them and fixed the fence. He had some vandalism on his property.
- In the winter he had 5,000 mink – the summer he has 30,000. He will be pelting in October/November. This contributes to the extra noise from the mink (one of her complaints)
- The smell – when it is extra hot in the day, and cools at night – the smell will be stronger (it's been a long hot summer)
- They store the manure in the summer in the shed, they just spread the manure on the fields (again, strong smell is seasonal). They are back to storing the manure.
- Dust complaint – he believes that is more to do with the corn crop than the mink.
- They are in the ALR with urban development right beside the farm.

Good afternoon,

I wonder if you could tell me more about what fur farms - specifically mink farms - are required to do in order to mitigate nuisances to neighbouring residential properties. We've been having more issues over the past few months than ever before.

I have lived in close proximity to what I have been told is a mink farm for about 18 months. I think the operation's address is s.79

Before we bought our home, we understood from the neighbourhood that the farm released smell, usually in the early morning or late evening; I presume so it is likely to offend the least amount of people. It has been bearable thus far, but for the past few months the smell has become quite offensive - strong, different than usual, more frequent, and long lasting. It has really embedded itself in our home, specifically our master bedroom, which is above the bushes and tree line and so has no impediment to dust and smell.

We notice that we suffer a lot more dirt and dust in our home than anywhere else we have lived and feel certain it is because of the farming operation. Again, much worse lately than usual.

Twice this summer, minks escaped the farm and were frolicking in our neighbours' backyards. One neighbour was able to get in touch with the farm, and they came over to trap the mink to take them back. The mink are also much easier to hear lately - their noises are noticeable most of the day and night.

The changes outlined above that we've easily noticed makes me wonder if their standards have slipped or if regulations are no longer being followed.

Is it possible to have an inspection carried out to ensure that proper mitigation techniques are being used by the farm in order to decrease the nuisances described above? I sometimes worry about

what these nuisances could be doing to our health, over time, and certainly loose animals in our backyards is a safety concern. Other neighbours have shared these same concerns and interest.

After receiving a complaint regarding conditions of your mink farm at the above address, Dr. Pawlik and myself inspected your farm. Though we did not go through all the sheds, this list is what was observed in the ones that we did inspect and was a good representation of the farm:

- Mild accumulation of dried old food on the wire cages in addition to the fresh food
- Many of the water dishes were dirty with accumulation of feed and other debris; translucent film on the water surface
- Moderate to strong smell of ammonia
- Dripping water lines contributing to standing water underneath cages
- Build-up of feces beneath the cages and in some cages
- Enrichments missing in many cages
- Enhancements missing in many cages
- No shavings in some nest boxes
- Mink with increased tear production and wet fur around the eyes (conjunctivitis)
- One of the mink was minimally responsive; squinting eyes
- Several mink had one or multiple digits that were noticeably swollen at the tips; affected digits were missing claws with sanguineous discharge
- One mink observed with mild to moderate facial swelling around the maxillary lip, nose and around the lower eye lid
- One mink was curled in the middle of the cage and minimally responsive; no obvious disease (face was hidden from view); cage mates were very active
- Several mink had tails with excessive grooming or sores on the tail tips
- One mink had clouding of the corneas with excessive tear production (keratoconjunctivitis)

- One mink had conjunctivitis with prolapse of the third eyelid
- Sick and injured mink not being treated
- Over-crowding of cages: Many instances where four mink were in a cage with approximately 300 sq inch of floor space and no additional shelf/platform

s.79 I understand you have had challenges this year with increased litter sizes and the extended hot summer. However, many of the above items are in non-compliance of the Code of Practice and licensing requirements under the *Fur Farm Regulations*.

The following are required to be corrected immediately:

- 1) Treat sick and injured mink according to your Health Management Plan or euthanize
- 2) Remove mink from the non-compliant undersized cages
- 3) Reduce the number of mink from the over-crowded cages
- 4) Clean manure buildup from cages
- 5) Clean water bowls that appear overly dirty
- 6) Repair dripping water lines in sheds that will be still used for mink
- 7) Remove old feed from top of cages
- 8) Enhancements and enrichments added to bare cages
- 9) Shavings to be added to bare nest boxes

I trust you will be able to complete the above items as soon as possible. I will plan another site visit October 11<sup>th</sup>.

In addition to Mike's notes, many of the water nipples were dripping and contributing to the standing water and smell. Many of the water bowls are green and slimy. s.79 is not treating any of the mink because he says he is just going to kill the ones that are injured (this rationale did not make sense since there were so many of them still in the cages). Many cages that did have appropriate numbers and sizes, had no shavings in the nest boxes.

He said he was in the process of moving the mink from the smaller cages or over-crowded cages to the cages in the back row – but, he said it was too hot to move them.

I told him I will summarize what needs to be done and email it to him, then go out again in the next couple weeks to see if it has been done.

We did not go through every shed, but got a pretty good idea of the condition of most of the farm.
