Buy BC Cost-Shared Partnership Program:

- Buy BC Partnership Program Cost-Shared Funding is available to applicants to undertake sector/product specific marketing and promotional activities to increase consumer demand and sales of BC agrifood and seafood products within the province.
- Eligible activities under this Program include:
 - Labelling Products/Packaging with a Buy BC Logo;
 - Marketing Collateral and Promotional Tools;
 - BC-Focused Market Development Activities; and,
 - Media Advertising
- Our Third Party Delivery Agent, the Investment Agriculture Foundation of BC (IAFBC), is primarily
 responsible for receiving applications and for administering and overseeing the program
 components in accordance with the Ministry's administrative guidelines for the Program.
 Together with the Ministry they form the decision making matrix which is outlined below.

The following outlines the decision component of the Buy BC Partnership Program:
