Good morning! As per our conversation last week:

- There were housekeeping amendments to the regulation but this has not changed the regulation intent and the number of horses allowed remains the same. See below for more detail.
- Commercial horse riding, training and boarding (which includes work horses for farming or ranching) is a farm use and an operator can have as many horses as they want.
- If you have 40 or fewer horses, commercial horse riding, training and boarding establishments have always been protected from local government or First Nation government prohibition.
- If a commercial horse riding, training and boarding establishment has more than 40 horses, a local government of First Nation government can prohibit them.
- For non-commercial horse riding, training and boarding establishments, if you have more than 40 horses for non-commercial purposes, then a non-farm use application would be required to be sent to the Agricultural Land Commission.
