Hi Gary,

My apologies for the delay in sending you my questions.

I appreciate your willingness to speak with me, particularly since this subject matter is, as you say, controversial. Given that fact, I would like to underscore the following: I am not writing this story because I have a political agenda. I am also not interested in writing a story that is inaccurate or that misrepresents anyone. I simply try my hardest to follow the facts wherever they lead. If you have any questions about my journalistic process and the ethical and epistemic philosophy on which it is founded, please don't hesitate to ask me them.

Here are my questions:

1. A <u>2015 CSAS report</u> about PRV concluded that there was a "low likelihood" that the presence of PRV in "farmed Atlantic and Pacific Salmon would have a significant impact on wild Pacific Salmon populations." Is this conclusion based in part on the fact that HSMI had not been reported on BC salmon farms at the time this CSAS report was being written?

GDM reply: Changing the name of a disease is not a threat to wild salmon.

I am not able to speak for the 15 other contributors or the three reviewers of the CSAS document. However, from my perspective, in 2015 we had good evidence that idiopathic cardiomyopathy (= unexplained heart disease) was diagnosed as the cause of death for about 2% of government audit samples. Available records dated back to 2006, with no evidence of change in prevalence over time. To the best of my knowledge, the diagnosis of HSMI in BC by one research group is simply a renaming of a subset of the fish that were otherwise diagnosed with idiopathic cardiomyopathy in the government audit program. Simply changing the name of the cause of death from "idiopathic cardiomyopathy" to "HSMI" would not have had any bearing on my recommendation for the final conclusion in the 2015 CSAS document. Likewise, whether people call me "Gary" or "Dr. Marty" has no bearing on my ability to assess the potential outcomes of a disease.

In support of my numbers, independent analysis of samples from the government audit program from 2011 – 2013 by Dr. Miller's research group reported Copyright they examined (Di Cicco et al. 2018. FACETS 3: 599–641), which is within the range of 1 – 3% that I have reported with the diagnosis of idiopathic cardiomyopathy (or, more recently, as idiopathic cardiopathy). The CSAS report provided details about my diagnosis of HSMI-like lesions in 2006: Copyright

Note that my 2006 report did not describe the lesions as "HSMI-like"; that assessment was made later.

An important note here is that many pathogens are associated with "HSMI-like" lesions in the heart: salmon alphavirus, piscine myocarditis virus, *Yersinia ruckeri*, *Piscirickettsia salmonis*, and *Renibacterium salmoninarum*. Also, most farm salmon are eventually infected with PRV after they are moved into seawater pens. It is reasonable to assume that some causes of HSMI-like lesions in the heart are not yet known. Therefore, I recommend **not** diagnosing "HSMI-like" lesions as HSMI, particularly in BC where the relationship between "HSMI-like lesions" and BC-PRV has not been demonstrated with controlled laboratory exposures (citations to supporting peer-reviewed scientific papers are in my answer to question #8).

2. Why did the Audit Program not collect samples of skeletal muscle tissue from salmon until 2013?

GDM reply: I was not in charge of deciding which organs were sampled by the Audit Program. My involvement was to report results from examination of the samples that we received for analysis. Some critics of the CSAS report have argued that it is misleading to write that these diagnoses "have not been consistent with a clinical pattern that matches HSMI," when the clinical data needed to assess if these lesions were due to HSMI was unavailable. What would you say to the critics?

GDM reply: The clinical data needed to assess if lesions were due to HSMI were available to government auditors, and one of the 2015 CSAS contributors, Dr. Ian Keith, was at the time a fish health veterinarian working with the government audit program.

As part of 30 on-site visits to BC salmon farms every quarter, government auditors assess the fish health records of licensed veterinarians that provide medical services for those farms. The audits include examination of (i) the fish in the pens, (ii) mortality records on the farm, and (ii) diagnostic results from analysis of farm salmon tissue samples collected by the government auditors and analyzed by an independently accredited diagnostic laboratory.

Why did the government auditors and pathologist not have regular access to details of the clinical signs?

GDM reply: By "regular" here I meant the *daily* access to farm data, which is available to the licensed veterinarians that provide medical services for the farms. As described above, government auditors *do* have access to details of clinical signs during 30 on-site audits of BC salmon farms every quarter.

An important note here is that no other group of livestock veterinarians worldwide are subjected to the level of scrutiny associated with participation in the government auditing program for BC salmon farms.

5. Some critics of the 2015 CSAS report have argued that since the auditors and pathologist did not have they could not have adequately verified the industry information about the health of their salmon, since information about the clinical signs is necessary for determining if any diseases, like HSMI, are present. How would you respond?

GDM reply: The clinical data needed to assess if lesions were due to HSMI were available to government auditors, and one of the 2015 CSAS contributors, Dr. Ian Keith, was at the time a fish health veterinarian working with the audit program.

As part of 30 on-site visits to BC salmon farms every quarter, government auditors assess the fish health records of licensed veterinarians that provide medical services for those farms. The audits include examination of (i) the fish in the pens, (ii) mortality records on the farm, and (ii) diagnostic results from analysis of farm salmon tissue samples collected by the government auditors and analyzed by an independently accredited diagnostic laboratory.

6. When I interviewed Kristi Miller, she said that she had tried to include into the CSAS report the information that her pathologist, Hugh Ferguson, had found lesions consistent with HSMI in salmon from fish farms. The team of scientists writing the report deferred to your view that these lesions were not HSMI, however. Would you agree that this is accurate?

GDM reply: I do not think that lesions in BC farmed Atlantic salmon are HSMI.

I agree that Hugh Ferguson had found lesions consistent with HSMI in salmon from fish farms, and as pointed out in question #3 above, these were reported in the 2015 CSAS report as Copyright I first reported that lesions I diagnosed were consistent with HSMI in BC-farmed Atlantic salmon as part of a 2008 case report to a salmon farm veterinarian. That report was made public in 2011 during the Cohen Commission hearings.

At a Feb. 2009 meeting of the Association of Aquaculture Veterinarians of BC (AAVBC), I discussed my diagnosis of unexplained heart disease with the participants. At this meeting European

fish pathologist Dr. Marian McLoughlin presented microscopic features that can be used to differentiate HSMI and the two other heart diseases known in Europe (i.e., "pancreas disease" and "cardiomyopathy syndrome"). I recall having a discussion about whether BC farm salmon had the clinical form of HSMI as described in Europe. Based on consultation among the participants and Dr. McLoughlin, we decided that we did not have HSMI (we also did not have cardiomyopathy syndrome or pancreas disease). Discussions over the past two years with many of the participants at the 2009 meeting have not changed our assessment, despite the 2017 scientific publication by one research group that diagnosed HSMI in BC.

7. Miller said that you had told the scientists writing the CSAS report that you had already analyzed the same fish as Ferguson and had not diagnosed HSMI. She said that you didn't have the skeletal muscle tissue necessary for diagnosing HSMI when you analyzed these samples, however. Therefore, she says that "it was incorrect" for you to say the lesions weren't consistent with HSMI "because he had no way of observing [HSMI] if he didn't take the proper tissues." How would you respond?

GDM reply: The information in this question is not correct on two levels:

 Dr. Miller's group has published that skeletal muscle is not needed for a diagnosis of HSMI in BC. In 2018, Dr. Miller's group published results from their analysis of samples from the BC government auditing program collected from 2011 - 2013 (Di Cicco et al. 2018. FACETS 3: 599– 641). They acknowledged that Copyright

In summary, Di Cicco et al. (2018)

reports several cases of HSMI in fish for which skeletal muscle was not available for pathology.

2. My diagnosis of HSMI-like lesions in 2013 was based on microscopic examination of heart and skeletal muscle. Regardless of whether skeletal muscle is needed for the diagnosis of HSMI, my analysis relevant to this comment included skeletal muscle, and this was reported publicly in 2013. Here is a copy of the relevant information that was released to the public in 2013 as part of an affidavit (highlighting added); I provided this information to several colleagues (including Dr. Miller in an e-mail dated Thu 2016-05-19 10:01 AM); my e-mails included the statement, "You are welcome to forward all or part of this e-mail". In 2016, the salmon farm veterinarian told me that the 2013 samples I examined were from the same farm that was used as the source of fish for Di Cicco et al. 2017 [PLoS ONE 12(2): e0171471]:

"Affidavit of Dr. Gary D. Marty sworn October 30, 2013, in Morton v. Minister of Fisheries and Oceans et al, Federal Court No. T-789-13

21. Have you tested fish for PRV and/or HSMI with results that contradict the results of your testing for MHC?

I have not tested fish for PRV and/or HSMI with results that contradict the results of my testing for MHC, but I have tested fish in which the suite of lesions was different than the groups of fish I examined from MHC or DFO.

As described in my answer to question #4, among all the testing I have done for HSMI (e.g., the BC Fish Health Auditing and Surveillance Program), I occasionally diagnose "unexplained heart lesions" as the cause of death. However, the prevalence of PRV in tested cases (80%) is the same as the prevalence of PRV among (i) groups of fish that die of other causes and (ii) healthy fish that are sampled for pretransfer screening.

In two cases submitted directly by a BC fish farm company other than Marine Harvest (one case in 2011 and one case from a different farm in 2013), I diagnosed unexplained heart lesions as the cause of death in all of the fish in the sample group. These cases were not tested for PRV, but based on other data there is an 80% chance that they would be PRV positive. In this year's case, I requested a second submission that included skeletal muscle for histopathology (skeletal muscle is not included in routine submissions for diagnostic purposes). One of the 10 fish included in the second submission had severe heart lesions but no skeletal muscle inflammation; therefore, this fish did not have HSMI. Three other fish had moderate to severe heart lesions along with mild inflammation of skeletal muscle; therefore, these fish had inflammation of the heart and skeletal muscle, which are two features of HSMI. However, the farm's veterinarian told me that the fish did not have clinical signs consistent with the description of the European syndrome HSMI (see Dr. Nylund's expert report, answer to his question 24). Because these BC fish did not have all features of the European syndrome HSMI (i.e., clinical features are different), it is not appropriate to diagnose HSMI in these fish. Without consistent clinical signs, a diagnosis of HSMI in these fish is likely to result another example of the diagnostic "confusion" described by Dr. Nylund in his expert report (i.e., the response to his question 22). The submission form submitted with the second BC sample included a history that stated, Copyright

(e.g., exposure to algal toxins) as the cause of disease rather than PRV. Also, if BC strains of PRV were causing HSMI, it is not plausible to have 80% of BC Atlantic salmon infected with PRV every year since 2006, but have only two cases of HSMI during that same period."

8. Miller said that she believed that you were downplaying the possibility that HSMI was the disease causing the lesions she and Ferguson found. She thinks you still downplay HSMI. How would you respond to that?

GDM reply: Extensive evidence does not support the diagnosis of HSMI in BC.

Evidence-based medicine is a fundamental part of my work as a board-certified anatomic veterinary pathologist. Since the late 1800s, controlled laboratory studies have been widely accepted in the medical community as the basis for determining the cause of disease. We have solid evidence from controlled laboratory studies that PRV readily infects farmed Atlantic salmon in BC, but BC salmon exposed to BC-PRV do not develop HSMI:

9. Stan Proboszcz has written in <u>Policy Options</u> that the key conclusions of the 2015 CSAS report "Copyright Copyright

Copyright " How do you respond to this?

GDM reply: The assessed risk of PRV to Pacific salmonids (salmon and trout) by the 2015 CSAS report is nearly identical to a white paper published in 2017 by an independent organization of American fish health experts.

One of the ways to identify bias is to compare the conclusion of concern with the conclusion from independent assessment. When this is done with the 2015 CSAS report, the conclusion by the independent organization is essentially identical.

The lead writer for this white paper is the fish pathologist for the Alaska Department of Fish and Game. Alaska prohibits the importation of Atlantic salmon for any reason, including aquaculture.

Noteworthy here is that conclusions that BC-PRV poses *more than low risk* to wild salmon are **not** consistent with the independent assessment by The Pacific Northwest Fish Health Protection Committee.

10. Some critics of the 2015 CSAS report have argued that it is inaccurate because it is misleading and omits crucial information. For example, they believe it is misleading to state that fish with lesions consistent with HSMI did not show the clinical signs, when the data about the clinical signs was unavailable. They believe it is misleading to say that "HSMI has never been reported" on a BC fish farm when the tissue samples necessary to diagnose HSMI weren't available until 2014, a year before the report came out. Et cetera. How do you respond to the characterization of the report as "inaccurate," even by the standards of what was known about HSMI in 2015, and not by the standards of what we know about HSMI now?

GDM reply: see answers to previous questions for the following information: Clinical data was available [question #s 3, 4, and 5] Skeletal muscle is not needed for an HSMI diagnosis [question # 7] Not mentioned previously is the statement in the CSAS about the sample prevalence of skeletal muscle inflammation in government audit samples: Copyright

11. How would you respond to claims that the DFO's CSAS science tends to be biased in favour of the fish farm industry?

GDM reply: In my experience, DFO's CSAS process does a good job of presenting available information to support evidence-based conclusions. See also my response to question #9.

Here is information on Shared Services BC charges for Information & Technology & Phone Services.

High-Level Description of Funding Model Changes:

- Basically, budgets for most of each Ministry's core IT and phone services have been transferred to SSBC. These items are core services, and are called "voted" / "baseline" services this includes things like computers, phones, etc. Since budgets for these items have been transferred to SSBC, they no longer bill for these on a monthly basis any more. As long as there is no overall increase in these services for the year, there is no charge for these items. If there is a net increase in voted services over the course of the year, SSBC will be charging clients at year-end for the increased amounts. We are in discussions with SSBC to determine how the charge for an increase in voted services will work and we will notify you once a process is in place.
- Some items, however are still billed for on a regular basis, and these are called "recovery" services this includes services such as "calling cards, voice installation services, MFD consumption charges, etc. The attached report is a summary of your "recovery services" for the period April to September 2015. What is incremental Storage?

What is the Incremental Storage Report?

Workplace Technology Services bills the client organization one pooled incremental storage charge for the entire client organization (at a Ministry Level).

CSD Information Management Branch has developed a report which calculates and breaks down incremental storage and costs by service, and by groups within the client

organization. Although there is some margin of error, this report allows cost distribution according to level of usage. The report also enables clients to identify where they can potentially reduce storage (and therefore costs).

How do I determine how storage is being utilized?

Checking E-mail storage:

- 1. Click on "Tools", "Mailbox Cleanup"
- 2. Click on "View Mailbox Size"
- 3. "Total size (including subfolders) indicates the amount of storage utilized
- 4. Reminder that 150MB (150,000 KB) is the base allocation (if everyone is above this amount, the organization will incur incremental storage charges)

Checking Personal H: drive storage:

- 1. Open Microsoft Explorer.
- 2. Click on the H: Drive
- 3. Press Ctrl-A (highlights all folders in the drive)
- 4. Right-click on the highlighted items and select "Properties"
- 5. The "Size" indicates the total H: drive storage used.
- 6. A good guideline / best-practice to use as an H drive benchmark is 1GB as a maximum.

How can I find large / old files in my inbox?

- 1. The Mailbox Cleanup tool can be utilized to find messages of a certain age/size
- 2. Click on "Tools", "Mailbox Cleanup"
- 3. There are 2 options to find specific items "Find items older than..." or "Find items larger than".
- 4. Enter the age/size limit, and select "Find"

5. The results will be displayed in the Advanced Find dialog box

How can I easily empty my "deleted items" folder?

When you delete a message from any folder other than the deleted items folder, outlook just moves the message to the deleted items folder (it still takes up space in your mailbox). To recover space in the mailbox, the deleted items folder should be emptied regularly.

- 1. Click on "Tools", "Mailbox Cleanup"
- 2. Click on "Empty" to permanently delete items from the "deleted items" folder
- 3. You can also view the size of this folder by clicking "View Deleted Items Size..."

How do I reduce the amount of storage being utilized?

The Incremental Storage Report is a good first step to help identify which areas are contributing most to incremental storage costs (i.e. e-mail, home drive, or shared drives). Depending on which area(s) are contributing most to incremental storage costs, a different approach/strategy may be utilized.

In terms of reducing incremental storage, all electronic records must be filed using the approved Administrative Records Classification Schedule (ARCS) or an Operational Classification Records Schedule (ORCS) that has been tailored to the mandate of the organization.

This is Catherine from the agriculture show La semaine verte on French CBC. I hope you are well.

I am trying to find out who determines the fertilisation recommendations for the province of BC. (I am looking at fertilisation amounts for let's say nitrogen, phosphorus on various crops).

I would assume it's a committee that sets these amounts, but I am trying to get a sense as to how it works in different provinces.

Here in Quebec, there's a big story right now because the committee responsible for that includes agronomists, but also representatives from farm input companies. I know the situation is similar in Ontario,

but I am curious about BC...

Recommendation

The B.C. Ministry of Agriculture provides guidance for nutrient management, including crop nutrient recommendations. These recommendations are the application rates of individual nutrients (e.g., nitrogen, phosphorus, or potassium) that are expected to benefit a particular crop type, for a particular region of B.C. The nutrients may come from a combination of fertilizers, manure, or other crop nutrients. The term "crop nutrient recommendations" or "crop nutrient requirements" is used in B.C. instead of "fertilizer recommendations."

The B.C. Ministry of Agriculture staff have responsibility for providing the crop nutrient recommendations, which are guidelines and not prescriptions. There are variations between farms in soils, crop varieties, irrigation systems, nutrient application methods, and financial conditions. These variations are valid reasons for crop advisors or farmers to adjust the crop nutrient recommendations.

The Code of Practice for Agricultural Environmental Management, a regulation, does not have or prescribe crop nutrient recommendations. Rather, this regulation is results-based: it defines soil testing requirements and a process to limit nutrient application rates when soil test results indicate a high degree of environmental concern about nitrogen or phosphorus losses from the field.
