Here is an update of where we are on the "Humane Slaughter" funding request.

To date I have been unable to get the electrician to give an estimate or do the work required for the project. I expect that will be coming soon. I have ordered the winch and hopefully it will arrive next week with appropriate accessories.

I will have one labour bill for about 8 to 10 hours. We needed some extra help when moving heavy beams and the roof.

We will be picking up a step stool for the shooter of the beef.

I expect that I will be fabricating the head lift.

I have been unable to locate a suitable pistol grip gun, but at this point will wait until all other items are finished. (I do have a cylindrical type gun which we use now as well as a spare one.

The roof is on and we were able to use the space for the lamb slaughter yesterday. We still need to complete gates that will be permanent fixtures.
