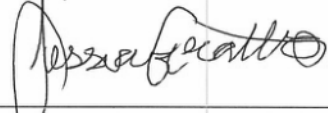

Good afternoon Arlene,

I have had interest from two parties regarding the creation of two new pound districts, one in the Cariboo and one in the Okanagan.

The one from the Cariboo has submitted an application without a fee, the Pound District would be two properties s.22 in Horsefly BC) and one of the property owners would act as Pound

Keeper.

The one in the Okanagan is still waiting to hear back from a couple of the neighbours and are trying to figure out a pound keeper / pound location prior to submitting their application. The boundaries for this pound district would be westerly to the Okanagan River Channel, northerly to the cattle guard on Black Sage Road next to Sage Greenhouses, southerly possibly to Road 22 extending on up to the boundary of the Osoyoos Indian Band Reserve. One of the main reasons for this pound district are problems caused by the horses from the Osoyoos Band running wild and damaging neighbouring properties / animals (a mare belonging to one of the land owners was "raped" by a runaway stallion causing quite severe damage to the horse and high vet bills). One of the local RCMP in the region have suggested that the RCMP would have more ability to deal with these loose horses if this region was a Pound District not a Livestock District.

As per the Pound Districts Regulation:

Application to establish a pound district

2 (1) Owners of land who wish to establish or disestablish a pound district pursuant to section 6 (1) of the *Livestock Act* shall submit an application to the director that includes

- (a) a description of the proposed or existing boundaries, as the case may be,
 - (i) by metes and bounds,
 - (ii) where there is a natural boundary, by reference to that boundary, or
 - (iii) by both metes and bounds and by reference to a natural boundary,
- (b) the number of owners of land in the area of the pound district or the proposed pound district and the method used to ascertain that number,
- (c) the name and address of a person who acts or is willing to act as a keeper for the pound district,
- (d) a legal description of the land on which the pound is to be or is located, and
- (e) other information that the director requires.

(2) Before submitting an application under this section, the applicants shall notify all owners of land outside a municipality who reside within the boundaries of the pound district, or the proposed pound district, as the case may be, that they will be submitting the application.

(3) The application shall

- (a) be signed by a majority of the owners of land outside a municipality who reside in the pound district, or the proposed pound district, as the case may be,
- (b) be accompanied by a non-refundable fee of \$150, and
- (c) contain a signed statement confirming
 - (i) that the requirements of section 2 have been met, and
 - (ii) how the landowners were notified.

[am. B.C. Regs. 233/86; 50/2016, s. 9.]

However, once they submit the application and the \$150 fee what are the next steps? I have no information related to the establishment of a pound district as I have no records of a new one being established since about the 1980's. Any suggestions / advice you or your staff can provide is greatly appreciated.

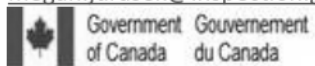

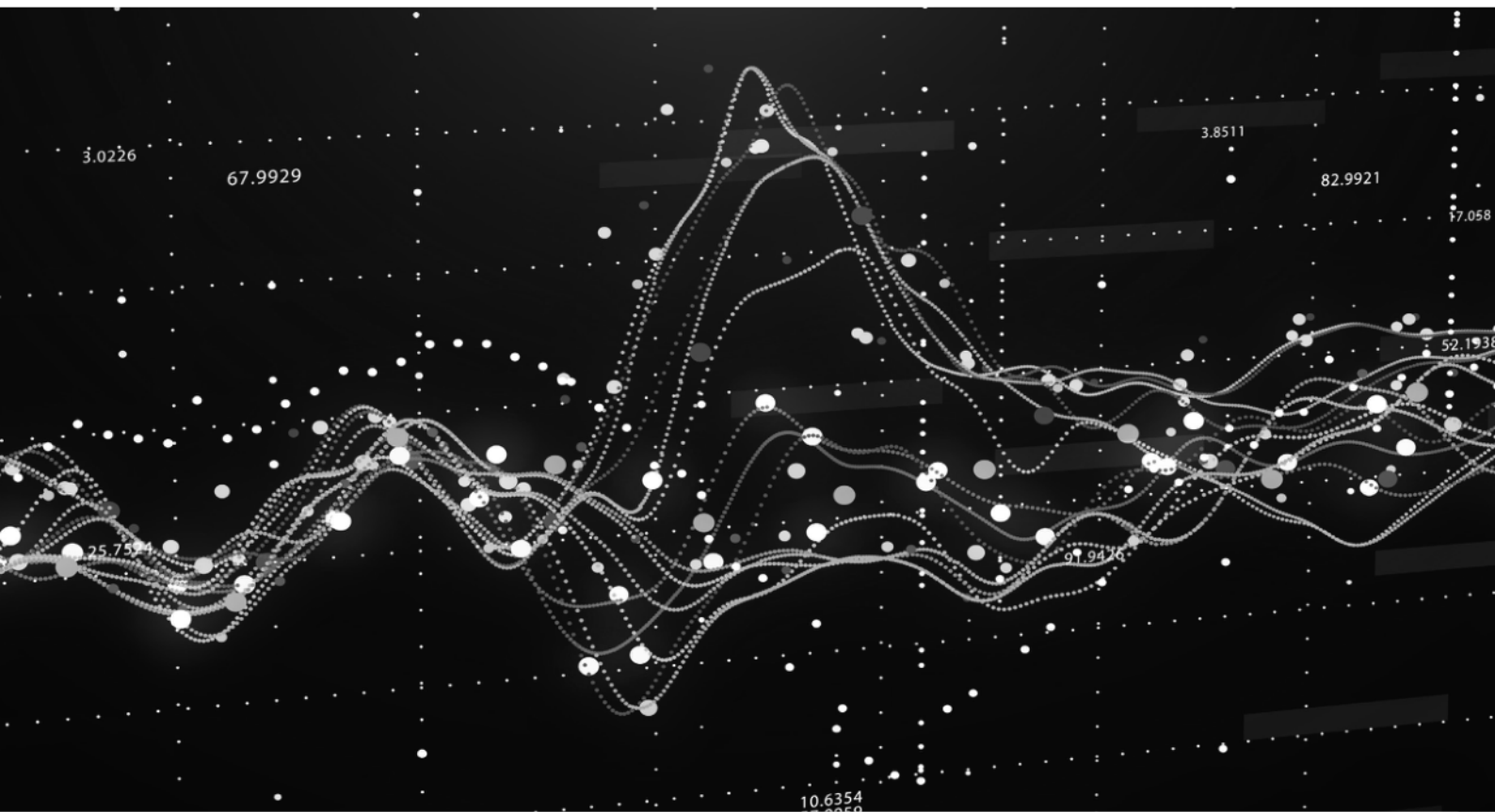

Hello staff,

Our Abbotsford building is currently under an evacuation order, and as a separate issue, we have experienced flooding at the building. At this time, we anticipate that it will take a few days to become operational once again. This will depend on the time it takes for the water to recede, to conduct building repairs and ensure safety for our return. Please note that no one is permitted inside the building at this time. Please keep in touch with your colleagues and managers and check your work email daily if you are able (<https://summer.gov.bc.ca/my.policy>).

Things we are doing:

- We will reach out to clients to let them know of our closure and that they may send urgent samples to PDS/Manitoba/Ontario and BSE samples to the CFIA lab in Lethbridge.
- We have informed CBRE of our freezers and samples and potential biohazards. They will not open our freezers unless a lab personnel is present.
- Business Continuity Planning for a return of basic functions in the short -term as well as medium and long-term regular functions – Just in case we need one.
- Regular updates with Ministry Executive about our situation and plans moving forward.

- Main floor is ok
- High water level for incinerator, basement, CL3 mechanical
- Power is on either from main supply or generator
- Gas is off

Outside of the lab, producers are trying to cope with the fallout of flooding. Some staff may be called upon to assist.

Returning to the Office

Change often brings worry or anxiety and returning to the office may be a big change for you. It's normal to feel uncomfortable about change, but there are steps you can take to reduce your concerns.



Self Assess

Step 1: What are you feeling? Write it down or say it aloud to acknowledge the feelings. If you name your concerns and feelings, it helps the brain to process.



Reassess

Step 3: Review, going back to Step 1. Identify what concerns are still there that Step 2 didn't address, then ask yourself, "is that a problem today?" If not, acknowledge the concern is still there, but remind yourself you can come back to it later when you have more control over the situation.



Reflect

Step 5: Know your signs of stress and check in with yourself often. Consider journaling to keep a record so you can see changes over time and to help identify and record those signs of stress to keep them in view.



Prepare & Practice

Step 2: Consider your concerns from Step 1: What can you do to reduce stress and by addressing each one? If you are concerned about office attire, consider dressing as you would to go to the office for a week prior, then re-use that clothing plan for your first week.



Monitor

Step 4: Covid is nothing if not a driving force of change. Consider revisiting Steps 1-3 often for changes that arise. Even with all the preparations, be prepared to adapt and improvise. Remember how resourceful you can be and trust yourself to find solutions that work for you.



Reach Out

Remember to access the resources that are available to support you. Don't wait until you are in the 'red', reach out as soon as you feel you struggling. If you notice others struggling, consider reaching out to them – we're all in this together but are on separate journeys.
