Avian Influenza (AI)	As of November 28th AI has been confirmed in 48 Infected Premises (IPs) in B.C. (152 since IPs since April 2022). All IPs except 3 detected since October 20th are commercial poultry in the Fraser Valley including the cities of Langley, Surrey, Chilliwack and Abbotsford. The Ministry Lab is currently providing AI testing services to meet the needs of the industry and the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) and is open 7 days a week.
	To reduce the risk of the virus spreading, the B.C.'s Chief Veterinarian issued an order on October 20, 2023 requiring all regulated, quota-holding chicken and turkey operations to maintain indoor operations. 	Although the risk to humans is low, the ministry is also working with public health officials from the BCCDC and Fraser Health to ensure that poultry producers are informed of their safety responsibilities as employers.
