**BACKGROUND:**

Ulkatcho First Nation is a Southern Carrier nation with a population of approximately 1080. They are located 315km northwest of Williams Lake and 180km to the east of Bella Coola.

As a remote community, there are very few amenities. The nearest bank is in Bella Coola. There is no cell service and the internet connection is not very good. There are no facilities for youth or elders. There was a receiving home for children and youth who were either waiting for court dates or were going into care that is now closed.
