Date Range for Record Search: From 01/01/2016 to 06/01/2017

Implementation and Lands Services Branch, MARR has records pertaining to two sites:

- Silverside, a former forestry vehicle maintenance shop located near Uchucklesaht Inlet on what is now Uchucklesaht Nation Treaty Settlement Land; and,
- Clakamucus, contaminated Provincial unauthorized fill adjacent to Yuułu?ił?ath Treaty Settlement Land, formerly Indian Reserve #2 – Clakamucus
