Modification Agreement

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BETWEEN

HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN IN RIGHT OF THE PROVINCE OF BRITISH COLUMBIA

represented by Minister of Children and Family Development

(the "Province", the "Minister", a "Director", "we", "us", or "our" as applicable)

AND

Adoptive Families Association of British Columbia

(the "Contractor", "you", or "your" as applicable)

A. The parties entered into an agreement number XNC196890 CSS and dated April 1, 2013, (the "Agreement").

B. The parties have agreed to modify the Agreement effective March 30, 2015

AGREEMENT

The parties agree as follows:

1. Client Services Schedule - extend funding period at top of page 1 and Part II 2.1 from March 31, 2014 to March 31, 2016
 - Part III - Section 3.2 Regional Services - change date from June 30, 2014 to June 30, 2015
 - Part III - Section 3.2 - add the following services.
 - a) Child specific recruitment program
 - Recruit and train recruiters for Victoria (1), Nanaimo (1) and Thompson-Cariboo Shuswap (1)
 - Outcomes - The services will result in 40 children being placed in permanent homes (Victoria/Nanaimo) and between 20 to 25 children being placed in permanent homes Thompson-Cariboo Shuswap.
 - b) Establish up to 650 seats for access to the Online Adoption Education Program
 - c) Establish child specific recruitment training sessions for Delegated Aboriginal Agencies consisting of 3 sessions of parts 2 and 3 in the following ministry service delivery areas - North SDAs, Interior SDAs, Lower Mainland SDAs or Vancouver Island.
 - d) Establish a consortium for Children to deliver SAFE Training - Dates and locations - September 2015 North SDAs, November 2015 Interior SDAs, January and April 2016 Vancouver SDAs and May 2016 Vancouver Island
 - e) Potential disbursement of Home Assessment funding. Ministry will provide names at time of potential disbursement.
 - f) Potential disbursement for Kevin Campbell: Vancouver Coastal
 - Part IV - Section 4.1 increase the amount not exceeding \$635,975 by \$750,000 to a new not to exceed amount of \$1,385,975
 - Part IV - Section 4.2 - delete a, b and c. Add d) The Province will pay a one-time only payment of \$750,000 within 10 days of modification signing.
 - This funding is provided as a financing arrangement to enable the Contractor to incur eligible expenses while providing the services.
 - Notwithstanding, Part IV Section 4.3 and 4.4, funds not used for the intended purpose, not expended, services that do not meet the quality assurance requirements or cancelling the contract during the term, these remaining funds will be reimbursed back to the Province.
 - The reimbursement date is as follows: On or before March 31, 2018 for services performed during the period of April 1, 2015 to March 31, 2016.
 - Part V - Section 5.1 - delete a and b. Add c) quarterly reports beginning July 1, 2015



2. In all other respects, the Agreement is confirmed.

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AGREEMENT

The parties agree as follows:

- 1. Part III - Section 3.2 - add the following services:
 - a) Revise the 1000familiesBC website to include foster and adoption options
 - b) Influence the BC Federation of Foster Parents Association and the Aboriginal Foster Parent Association to participate in planning recruitment campaigns as well as creating appropriate landing pages on their own websites for the purposes of potential recruits. In performing the services, financial support to both organizations may be provided within the limits of this one time only funding.
 - c) Plan a social media campaign for the upcoming year with an emphasis during the Foster Parent Appreciation month which is October and the Adoption Awareness month which is November.
 - f) Create and develop print material that can be used by the Ministry and DAA staff for foster parent targeted recruitment initiatives.
- Part IV - Section 4.1 increase the amount not exceeding \$1,385,975 by \$200,000 to a new not to exceed amount of \$1,585,975
- Part IV - Section 4.2 Add e) The Province will pay a one-time only payment of \$200,000 within 10 days of modification signing.
