As a follow up to our areas of discussion, we would also like to touch on some of our concerns about data collection, if there is someone who might be able to speak to this, or would be interested in a critical analysis of some of the current data collection methods? I've spoken with U of T and their ECE 2017 study already; the data being used for analysis and subsequent recommendations in various reports is originating from MCFD, rather than the health boards, and has some areas of concern that are leading to outcomes that are, depending on your perspective, situated in the alternative-fact realm. I'm an "informed policy" kind of person, and so when there are a few flags about the foundational data points, I begin to worry about the validity of the ultimate outcomes.






