#### Government's child care goals over the next three years:

- The Province's plan for early care and learning is to move from the current patchwork of programs and services – delivered with limited accountability and regulation, and with fees that are out of reach for many families – towards universal child care that is affordable and available for any family that wants it or needs it.
- By bringing down fees for parents, building licensed spaces, and working to support and increase the
  number of qualified Early Childhood Educators (ECEs), we are taking the first important steps towards a
  universal system of early care and learning.

#### The Child Care Fee Reduction Initiative:

- Starting in April 2018, licensed group or family infant/toddler and/or 3-5 years child care providers enrolled in the CCOF program will be invited to participate in the Child Care Fee Reduction Initiative (CCFRI).
- At the time of application, providers are asked to confirm their parent fees for each type of care (as of September 1, 2017, January 1, 2018 and April 1, 2018), and confirm any pre-planned parent fee increases for the duration of the contract term. For more information on how the ministry will assess providers' fee increases please see the <u>CCFRI – Key Facts for Providers</u>.
- Licensed providers who are approved to join this voluntary initiative will receive an increase of approximately 10% on their individual CCOF base rates for 2018/19 to support operational expenses.

- The application deadline for applying for the CCFRI has been extended to April 20, 2018, to allow providers
  more time to opt-in for April payments. Organizations can also apply to opt into the initiative at any time
  to during the contract term.
- In order to ensure that providers have accurate information as to how the Initiative will work, the ministry has sent information to all licensed providers currently in receipt of CCOF from government.
- Additional information for parents and providers is available on the <u>CCOF web site</u>

### **Funding to Providers and Parents**

- By providing funding through this program, it allows all families regardless of income to receive relief with their child care costs.
- In addition to directly lowering fees for families with children in licensed care, Budget 2018 will also fund a new affordable child care benefit.
- This new benefit, beginning in September 2018, will significantly lower the cost of child care for more British Columbian (BC) families. Families with pre-tax incomes of \$45,000 or less will receive the benefit, up to the cost of care, while those who make up to \$111,000 will receive a reduced amount, scaling according to income. Benefit amounts will ramp up, helping up to 86,000 familes by the end of 2020-21.

#### **Major and Minor Capital Funding Programs:**

- The Child Care Major Capital Funding program supports child care providers to build, renovate or expand existing child care facilities to create new licensed child care spaces.
- Additionally, the Child Care Minor Capital Funding program provides funding for emergency repairs, replacements, and relocations. This funding is intended to support existing child care spaces to remain operational, and can be used for:
  - Emergency upgrades or repairs to existing facilities;
  - Emergency replacement of furnishings and equipment necessary to comply with the Child Care Licensing Regulation; and/or,
  - Relocation costs when a child care facility is moving to another location.
- As you may be aware, Government committed \$237 million in Budget 2018 to improve access to child care, including funding to create more than 22,000 new licensed spaces throughout the province.
- We are introducing many new supports through expanded Major and Minor Capital Funding programs to help providers better serve their families. We will provide more information on these changes shortly; please continue to check the <u>Major Capital</u> and <u>Minor Capital</u> Program websites for more detail as it becomes available.

#### Supporting private operators

- Given the current crisis in the child care sector, there is recognition that we need to support the existing
  array of licensed spaces (both private and non-profit), and incent the creation of new spaces in order to
  meet demand.
- Budget 2018 includes new supports to help private and not-for-profit providers better serve their families and maintain their operations, including:
  - Licensed private Family Child Care providers will be eligible to apply for funding through the Child Care Minor Capital Funding program in 2018/19.
  - The CCFRI's enhanced operational funding lift is eligible to all licensed providers caring for children "under 36 months" and/or "3 years to Kindergarten," regardless of whether the organization is non-profit or private; and

 Start-up grants will be made available for unlicensed (private) child care providers to become licensed, assisting with the costs of receiving training and establishing a Family Child Care in their private residence.

## **Recruiting Supporting ECEs**

- The recruitment and retention of qualified ECEs and other child care providers is one of the most pressing challenges to developing universal child care, and we recognize that educators are the backbone of quality child care.
- As you may be aware, the province's strong labour market is currently drawing qualified, experienced ECEs into other sectors and alternate career paths, and we know the planned expansion of licensed child care spaces across the province will contribute to increased demand for trained ECEs.
- As part of Budget 2018, we are investing \$136 million over three years for a recruitment and retention strategy for ECEs.
- We are starting our work by creating a workforce development strategy that includes consideration of appropriate remuneration.
- The first step will be to undertake a labour market research project, which will seek input from the sector to help us better understand the complexities of the child care workforce, and how wages and benefits differ across the sector. This important work will provide government with a clear picture of the workforce in order to appropriately target any future initiatives effectively. More information regarding the labour market research will be forthcoming over the next several months.
- Other initiatives being undertaken to support ECEs include investments through the Early Learning and Child Care (ELCC) Agreement with the Government of Canada to support education and professional development.
- Budget 2018 is also supporting an increase to the number of seats available in public post-secondary ECE programs to boost the number of students able to access ECE education. We are also expanding the ECE Pedagogical Community Facilitators Program over the next few years, to support ECEs in their communities with enhancing the quality of their programs.
- Supporting the Early Care and Learning workforce is a complex undertaking, and we are confident these initiatives will be an important first step in supporting the sector.

We are very sorry for the delay in this response. It went through a different route and was slower than it should have been. Any MCFD requests or correspondence you have, including childcare, can be routed through me for the quickest access.

I understand that MLA Hunt received an email on behalf of a constituent regarding the closure of s.22 s.22

The Ministry recognizes that there is a chronic shortage of licensed child care spaces in our province that has left many families struggling to find quality childcare. In order to improve access and support the transition to universal child care, we are providing \$237 million to build 22,000 new licensed spaces province-wide. Combined with the new spaces we are creating with the federal government, as part of the Early Learning and Child Care agreement, room for 24,000 more children to access quality, affordable child care, and laying a strong foundation for universal child care in B.C. Investing \$136 million over three years to enhance quality of care, including new supports for training and development, as well as workforce development strategy. This will help to increase the recruitment and retention of Early Childhood Educators in order to boost the availability of these important and valued child care experts.

We are also encouraging existing unlicensed providers become licensed by providing start-up grants to unlicensed family providers to become licensed.

Providers will be able to apply for a grant that provides \$500 to cover costs associated with becoming licensed (e.g., first aid training, fees) and \$500 per space for equipment, for up to seven spaces per provider, for a total of up to \$4,000 per application.

Once a provider becomes licensed, they will be eligible for additional funding to pass on a child care fee reduction to parents using their services, as part of our affordability commitments under Child Care B.C. Families may also receive a higher level of support through the new affordable child care benefit which will be introduced in September 2018.

These supports include an expanded Minor Capital program. Minor Capital Funding is intended to support existing child care spaces to remain operational, and can be used for:

Emergency upgrades or repairs to existing facilities;

Emergency replacement of furnishings and equipment necessary to comply with the Child Care Licensing Regulation; and/or,

Relocation costs when a child care facility needs to move to another location.

A more flexible Child Care Major Capital program will be introduced. The Child Care Major Capital Funding Program funds new builds, renovations to existing facilities, to support the creation of new licensed child care

spaces. Since 2014, the Province has invested \$59.5 million to support the creation of more than 8,100 new licensed child care spaces across B.C. through four intakes.

More information regarding the changes to these programs will be available in the coming weeks and months. The public is asked to check the <u>Major Capital</u> and <u>Minor Capital</u> program websites for more details, as they become available, and to watch the <u>New Child Care Improvements in B.C.</u> site for the new initiatives coming out.

Child care organizations are independent business operators who negotiate lease agreements without involvement from the province. The ministry does not have the authority to intervene in matters between a tenant and landlord.

### Constituent \$.22

Budget 2018 announced the details of government's move towards universal child care, in <u>Child Care B.C., Caring for Kids, Lifting Up Families: the Path to Universal Child Care,</u> including a three-year investment of \$136 million in the ECE workforce. Through this plan, government will work closely with other governments, child care providers, parents and communities to strengthen early care and learning as we lay the groundwork for universal child care.

Early Childhood Educators (ECEs) are critical to the quality of early care and learning in licensed child care facilities. We cannot build a universal child care system without a qualified and well-supported workforce. The need for qualified ECEs will increase proportionately with the planned expansion of child care spaces across the province.

Under *Budget 2018*, government will work closely with other governments, child care providers, parents and communities to strengthen early care and learning as we lay the groundwork for universal child care.

Budget 2018 invests 136 million over three years to implement a recruitment and retention strategy. Work is starting by creating a workforce development strategy that will include consideration of appropriate remuneration; this will begin by seeking input from the sector through labour market research project in the coming months. We will also be providing additional funding of \$10 million through the Early Learning and Child Care (ELCC) Agreement with the Government of Canada to expand and enhance the current ECE Bursary Program, to encourage and support more people to pursue careers in the field. More information on the expanded ECE Bursary Program and the application process will be available through the Early Childhood Educators of BC (ECEBC) in the coming months.

Budget 2018 is also investing \$7.4 million to create new student spaces over the next three years in public post-secondary ECE programs. This is anticipated to increase the number of ECE graduates from public institutions by 620 over the next three years. Additional new ECEs are anticipated to join the workforce through new graduates from private post-secondary institutions, newcomers, people from other provinces, people moving from other occupations, and people staying in the ECE field for longer periods.

In addition to the funding being directed towards ECE post-secondary education, government is also investing in quality professional development opportunities for early care and learning professionals in two ways:

Enhancing the funding available to the ECE Pedagogy Network—which offers the ECE Community Pedagogical Facilitators Program—so the program can be expanded throughout the province over the next several years. This program allows child care professionals to participate in learning circles together with the guidance of a Pedagogical Facilitator, who can also work alongside professionals in their programs to build upon the quality care and learning they are providing.

Investing an additional \$6.3 million of ELCC Agreement funding in 2018/19 in professional development; details about how this money will be used will be released later this year.

Government is confident these new measures will assist in the recruitment and retention of ECEs across the province and will begin to address some of the barriers to education that individuals seeking ECE certification may face.




