ISSUE: Update on the progress of implementation of the In-Care Network in the context of pandemic recovery

BACKGROUND:

The Ministry of Children and Family Development (the ministry) is delivering on commitments made to reform the Contracted Residential Agency (CRA) system in <u>response</u> to the Office of the Auditor General (OAG) of BC's 2019 <u>report</u> Oversight of Contracted Residential Services for Children and Youth in Care, through the implementation of the In-Care Network and other key ministry projects. Re-examining the role CRA's play within the in-care system is a core aspect of the ministry's work to create a responsive network of supports and services for children, youth and families supported by the ministry under its overarching Strategic Framework.

The ministry is using a process called Modelling the System as a means of service design/evaluation to implement the In-care Network (see appendix A for a visual description of the Modelling the System process).

This work was temporarily interrupted by COVID-19 and pandemic response and planning. The following note provides an update on how the Ministry has prioritized the In-Care Network as part of its COVID-19 recovery planning.


