

#### **CONFIDENTIALITY UNDERTAKING**

The Province of British Columbia, as represented by the Ministry of Children and Family Development (the "Ministry"), has invited you to participate in the Minister's Advisory Council for Children and Youth with Support Needs (CYSN MAC). As a participant of the CYSN MAC, you will receive information and engage in discussions that are confidential. As such, the Ministry requires this undertaking.

- 1. For the purposes of this undertaking, "Confidential Information" means any information disclosed by the Ministry, in writing, verbally or in any other form or media, to you as a member of the CYSN MAC.
- You hereby undertake and agree as follows:
  - a. to hold Confidential Information in confidence;
  - b. to not, at any time, including after your participation in the CYSN MAC has ended, use:, publish, release or disclose, or permit to be used, published, released or disclosed Confidential Information, except insofar as is necessary to enable you to fulfill your obligations as a member of the CYSN MAC.
  - c. to use Confidential Information solely to participate in the CYSN MAC and to not, either directly or indirectly, use Confidential Information for any other purpose or in any other manner except with the prior written consent of the Ministry;
  - d. to not make copies of Confidential Information;
  - e. to store Confidential Information securely so that no other person has access to it;
  - f. to return to the Ministry all Confidential Information in your possession in accordance with the Ministry's direction once your participation in the Working Group has ended or upon written request by the Ministry.
- 3. Nothing in this undertaking shall apply to any Confidential Information:
  - a. which, at the time of its disclosure to you, is in the public domain; or
  - b. which you are required to disclose by law.

- 4. You hereby acknowledge that:
  - a. In your capacity as a member of the CYSN MAC, you can discuss Confidential Information with Ministry staff, legal counsel retained by the government or employed by the Legal Services Branch in the Ministry of Justice, or another person whom the Ministry identifies as having given a confidentiality undertaking in relation to Confidential Information;
  - b. Confidential Information may be protected by Cabinet confidentiality, the parliamentary convention on confidentiality of proposed bills, and solicitor-client privilege; and in providing Confidential Information to you as a member of the Working Group, it is not the intention of the Ministry or the Province of British Columbia to waive solicitor-client privilege or to waive, defeat or negate any privilege or confidence, or any other protection provided by law, that applies to Confidential Information.

MAC Minutes - May 2021

The first meeting spanned two (2) three (3)-hour sessions on Zoom on May 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>.

The first day (May 5<sup>th</sup>) opened with an inspiring blessing from Elder May Sam of Tsartlip Nation. She commented that we were "building our foundation" and indeed much of the day was spent learning about each other, our backgrounds, and acknowledging what each member brings to this Minister's Advisory Council.

In these foundational meetings, some core guiding documents and principles were reviewed so that all members of the Minister's Advisory Council (MAC) were clear on their membership role, how they could have an impact based on their lived and professional experiences, and the vision for this meeting and future sessions.

Important questions were asked about the Terms of Reference which both Minister Mitzi Dean, along with Ministry of Children and Family Development team, committed to reviewing and clarifying for the future.

Each council member was given an opportunity to reflect on the introduction before the first day closed out

At the beginning of second day (May 6<sup>th</sup>), the council was again warmly welcomed by Elder May Sam.

Quickly thereafter, Ministry staff spent most of the meeting addressing a variety of policy matters. Members were placed into breakout sessions where they were encouraged to respond and add feedback, which was tracked for Ministry staff to review.

After the breakout sessions were concluded, a moment was allotted for any lingering questions or concerns before moving into the conclusion, once again with the gratitude of Elder May Sam.

The Minister's Advisory Council delved into some key policy items as well as acknowledged the vast and various experience that forms the council. The next sessions are currently being planned to dive deeper into the key policy issues.
