**ISSUE:** Notice of Intent for evaluation framework to inform the CYSN Service Framework

implementation

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) is developing a Children and Youth with Support Needs (CYSN) Service Framework to contribute to the overall efforts of the Ministry in strengthening its approach to prevention, early intervention and family preservation. It is intended to clarify and explain MCFD's system of supports, guide planning and establish an approach to the delivery and access of CYSN services that is driven by the needs of children, youth and families and reflects current research. An important aspect of this work will be to create an evaluation framework and identify tools that can be used to monitor and evaluate the implementation of the CYSN Service Framework and the needs-based assessment process.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The new CYSN service model will be prototyped prior to provincial implementation. Prototyping of the system shift allows government to test the changes on a smaller scale, identify challenges, and develop solutions to apply to provincial implementation. To support the prototyping and subsequent provincial implementation, an evaluation plan is required to inform a comprehensive evaluation that will allow government to understand the impacts and outcomes of the system shift. Evaluation of the system shift is essential to ensure we are moving toward the improved outcomes the system changes are intended to achieve.

CanChild, housed within the School of Rehabilitation Science at McMaster University, has been provided a direct award contract with MCFD to complete research that provides recommendations on an evidence-informed approach to assessing child and youth functional abilities, strengths and needs. This research will support the CYSN system to shift to a needs-based system as articulated within the CYSN Service Framework.

CanChild has expertise in child and family centred care, evaluation measures related to quality of life and participation of children and youth with disabilities, and given their current needs-based assessment contract with MCFD, CanChild is the preferred organization to create an evaluation framework for the CYSN Service Framework implementation.

The Early Years and Inclusion Policy branch base budget has made a soft commitment dedicated to CYSN Service Framework Knowledge Transfer  $_{s,13;}^{s,12;}$  establish a Modelling Expert

Panel s.13; these soft commitments were a result of anticipating publicly releasing the service framework in Fall 2020 and potentially modelling the system on a much smaller scale sooner that currently planned. Given the shifts in timing, it is proposed that this base budget is redirected to support enhance the work with CanChild to support us in setting up an evaluation process for prototyping the system.

#### **SUMMARY:**

To move forward with the implementation of the CYSN Service Framework, an evaluation framework will be required to assess whether the CYSN system changes are achieving the intended outcomes. Dovetailing with work CanChild is already conducting for MCFD related to the CYSN Service Framework implementation and needs-based assessment process, CanChild is the preferred organization to deliver the evaluation framework required and the Ministry will proceed with direct award for this work.

ISSUE: CYSN Service Framework engagement to design hub and spoke service model

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) is developing a Children and Youth with Support Needs (CYSN) Service Framework to contribute to the overall efforts of the Ministry in strengthening its approach to prevention, early intervention, and family preservation. It is intended to clarify and improve access to MCFD's system of supports available to children and youth with support needs and their families, guide planning and establish an approach to accessing and delivering CYSN services that is driven by the needs of children, youth and families. An important aspect of this work will be to design the hub and spoke system that will deliver developmental and goal focused services through contracted agencies.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Within the CYSN Service Framework, four core services available to families are identified: Developmental, Goal Focused, Disability and Customized Complex services. Developmental and Goal Focused services will be delivered by a community-based hub and spoke model which will make it easier to find and access services using a central point of contact for MCFD CYSN and/or Indigenous CYSN services. The hub and spoke model will be delivered by contracted agencies.

An MCFD staff Advisory Circle has been assembled and has been engaged in designing the hub and spoke service model. The Advisory Circle consists of representatives from:

- Inclusion Strategic Policy
- Specialized Provincial Services (A/Executive Director)
- Service Delivery Division (Director of Provincial Operations, Directors of Operations, Quality Assurance)
- Practice Division (Director of Practice)
- Information Services Division
- Finance and Corporate Services (Financial Services Branch, Procurement and Contract Management Branch, Procurement Strategy team within Corporate Operations Branch, Modelling Analysis and Information Management)
- Strategic Services (Project Management, Change Management and Communications)

**ISSUE:** Contract modification for continuation of CYSN needs-based assessment and evaluation framework research

#### **BACKGROUND:**

The Ministry of Children and Family Development (MCFD) is developing a Children and Youth with Support Needs (CYSN) Service Framework to contribute to the overall efforts of the Ministry in strengthening its approach to prevention, early intervention and family preservation. It is intended to clarify and explain MCFD's system of supports, guide planning and establish an approach to the delivery and access of CYSN services that is driven by the needs of children, youth and families and reflects current research. An important aspect of this work will be to develop and validate a needs-based assessment approach and evaluation framework to monitor and evaluate the implementation of the CYSN Service Framework.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

CanChild, housed within the School of Rehabilitation Science at McMaster University, has been provided a direct award contract with MCFD to complete research that provides recommendations on 1) an evidence-informed approach to assessing child and youth functional abilities, strengths and needs, and 2) an evaluation framework to monitor and evaluate the implementation of the CYSN Services Framework.

The contract was initiated in January 2021. At the end of March, a presentation to MCFD officials around preliminary recommendations was provided, with final recommendations due May 15, 2021. Initial feedback from MCFD staff on the preliminary recommendations (attendees included Director and Executive Director of Practice, Director of Provincial Practice, Executive Directors of Service, Director of Inclusion Strategic Policy and Executive Director of Early Years, Indigenous Early Years and Inclusion Policy, Acting Deputy Director of Aboriginal Services Branch) suggested that further information on the cultural appropriateness of the proposed tools for Indigenous communities is required.

#### **OPTIONS:**

**Option 1: (Recommended)** Approve modification of CanChild contract for continuation of needs-based assessment and evaluation work.

*Implications*:

- Allows for research that is critical to the CYSN Service Framework implementation to be continued in a timely way
- Allows for scope to be expanded to ensure cultural appropriateness of process, tools and measures.
- Allows broader external engagement to inform the research and recommendations including consultation with parents, youth/adults with lived experience, Indigenous communities, and service providers.
- Supports building on the evaluation framework with a coordinated approach that includes feedback from service providers.

- Allows for continued work to understand eligibility thresholds of the suggested tools
- Includes evaluation of the evaluation framework and functional assessment tools through focused engagement in the fall with families and service providers.

ISSUE: Modernization of respite funding under the CYSN Service Framework.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Respite is offered as a continuum of service that contributes to child/youth and family quality of life, reduces overall family stress, and builds family capacity (see Appendix A). Traditionally respite has been offered as in-person caregiver support provided either in the family home, in the caregiver's home, or in the community. While its purpose was originally defined as a "temporary break" for parents, it is now more widely recognized that there are a range of services and supports that could provide similarly positive outcomes for families, such as: meal delivery, grocery shopping assistance, housekeeping supports, sibling care, community programs, funding for camps, and may also include traditional caregiver support.

The current system of respite supports has been criticized as inadequate. It has not been changed significantly, either in scope or funding amounts, since its inception in 1989. The new continuum of respite services, within the new CYSN Service Framework, will allow for innovative family-centred solutions that reflect the diversity and support the inclusion of children and youth with disabilities and their families. The need for this service is identified by CYSN Workers in planning with families and can be adjusted as the family situation evolves.

This service is primarily delivered in two ways:

- Direct Funded: Funding is given to the parent/caregiver to buy respite services directly.
- Agency Coordinated: A contracted service provider arranges respite for a family or group of families that are referred by MCFD. Families can be offered this option if capacity exists in their community and if they would benefit from having support with recruitment and retention of caregivers, and coordination of that service.

Currently (as of Dec 2020), there are 5800 families who access direct funded respite and 1000 who access agency coordinated respite. Agency coordinated respite is currently available in 8 of our 13 Service Delivery Areas (SDA) in the province, and primarily in larger communities.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The importance of respite to families of children/youth with support needs cannot be understated. There is a shift in the conceptualization and a reframing of respite as an outcome, rather than an input<sup>1</sup> and a "break from stress" instead of the traditional "break from caregiving duties". This modernized approach in respite provides additional opportunities for improved quality of life outcomes and overall family functioning. It creates more culturally responsive options allowing for differing perspectives on disability and how children, youth and families

are best supported and allows families to reduce stressors without requiring the child/youth to have time away from their primary caregiver, which may not be in their interests. Modernizing our understanding of, and approach to, respite aligns with a human rights-based approach to equity and supports the intent of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD)² including the guiding principle of "Respect for inherent dignity, individual autonomy including the freedom to make one's own choices, and independence of persons". It supports the values in the CYSN Service Framework to be strengths and needs based, accessible, and promote more meaningful social inclusion. Specific guiding principles for the respite continuum will align with these values and will be consistent across all respite services that support children/youth regardless of their care status.
